6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
7	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much of it as may be
8	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the Coronavirus
9	State Fiscal Recovery Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the
10	Department of Finance and Administration - Office of Insurance for
11	the purpose of reimbursing the State and School Employees' Life
12	and Health Insurance Plan for eligible expenses incurred on or
13	after March 3, 2021, through June 30, 2024, for the fiscal year
14	beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2024
15	\$ 35,000,000.00.
16	SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section and Section 3 of
17	this act, the term "department" means the Department of Finance
18	and Administration.

19	(2) The department shall not disburse any funds appropriated
20	under this act to any recipient without first: (a) making an
21	individualized determination that the expenditure sought is, in
22	the department's independent judgment, for necessary expenditures
23	eligible under Section 602 of the federal Social Security Act as
24	added by Section 9901 of the federal American Rescue Plan Act of
25	2021 (ARPA) and its implementing guidelines, guidance, rules,
26	regulations and/or other criteria, as may be amended or
27	supplemented from time to time, by the United States Department of
28	the Treasury; and (b) determining that the recipient has not
29	received and will not receive reimbursement for the expense in
30	question from any source of funds, including insurance proceeds,
31	other than those funds provided under Section 602 of the federal
32	Social Security Act as added by Section 9901 of ARPA. In
33	addition, the department shall ensure that all funds appropriated
34	under this act are disbursed in compliance with the Single Audit
35	Act (31 USC Sections 7501-7507) and the related provisions of the
36	Uniform Guidance, 2 CFR Section 200.303 regarding internal
37	controls, Sections 200.330 through 200.332 regarding sub-recipient
38	monitoring and management, and subpart F regarding audit

40 **SECTION 3.** (1) As a condition of receiving and expending the funds appropriated to the department under this act, the 41 42 department shall certify to the Department of Finance and Administration that each expenditure of the funds appropriated to 43

requirements.

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- 44 the department under this act complies with the guidelines,
- 45 guidance, rules, regulations and/or other criteria, as may be
- 46 amended from time to time, of the United States Department of the
- 47 Treasury regarding the use of monies from the Coronavirus State

- 49 (2) If the Office of Inspector General of the United States
- 50 Department of the Treasury, or the Office of Inspector General of
- 51 any other federal agency having oversight over the use of monies
- 52 from the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund established by
- 53 ARPA (a) determines that the department or recipient has expended
- or otherwise used any of the funds appropriated to the department
- 55 under this act for any purpose that is not in compliance with the
- 56 quidelines, guidance, rules, regulations and/or other criteria, as
- 57 may be amended from time to time, of the United States Department
- 58 of the Treasury regarding the use of monies from the Coronavirus
- 59 State Fiscal Recovery Fund established by ARPA, and (b) the State
- 60 of Mississippi is required to repay the federal government for any
- 61 of those funds that the Office of the Inspector General determined
- 62 were expended or otherwise used improperly by the department or
- 63 recipient, then the department or recipient that expended or
- 64 otherwise used those funds improperly shall be required to pay the
- 65 amount of those funds to the State of Mississippi for repayment to
- 66 the federal government.
- 67 **SECTION 4.** The money appropriated by this act shall be paid
- 68 by the State Treasurer out of any money in the Coronavirus State

- 69 Fiscal Recovery Fund not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants
- 70 issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer
- 71 shall issue his or her warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 72 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
- 73 **SECTION 5.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 74 and after July 1, 2023.
