1 AN ACT MAKING AN ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT 2 OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION - OFFICE OF INSURANCE FOR THE 3 PURPOSE OF REIMBURSING THE STATE AND SCHOOL EMPLOYEES' LIFE AND 4 HEALTH INSURANCE PLAN FOR ELIGIBLE EXPENSES INCURRED DURING A 5 CERTAIN PERIOD, FOR THE PERIOD BEGINNING UPON THE PASSAGE OF THIS 6 ACT AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2024.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 8 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much of it as may be 9 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the Coronavirus 10 State Fiscal Recovery Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration - Office of Insurance for 11 12 the purpose of reimbursing the State and School Employees' Life 13 and Health Insurance Plan for eligible expenses incurred on or after March 3, 2021, through June 30, 2024, for the period 14 15 beginning upon the passage of this act, and ending June 30, 2024.. .....\$ 35,000,000.00. 16 SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section and Section 3 of 17 18 this act, the term "department" means the Department of Finance 19 and Administration.

No. 1717 **MANUAL MANUAL AND A OFFICIAL ~** A1/2 23/HR31/R2186SG PAGE 1 (RF\JAB) 20 (2)The department shall not disburse any funds appropriated 21 under this act to any recipient without first: (a) making an 22 individualized determination that the expenditure sought is, in 23 the department's independent judgment, for necessary expenditures 24 eligible under Section 602 of the federal Social Security Act as 25 added by Section 9901 of the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 26 2021 (ARPA) and its implementing guidelines, guidance, rules, regulations and/or other criteria, as may be amended or 27 28 supplemented from time to time, by the United States Department of 29 the Treasury; and (b) determining that the recipient has not 30 received and will not receive reimbursement for the expense in question from any source of funds, including insurance proceeds, 31 32 other than those funds provided under Section 602 of the federal 33 Social Security Act as added by Section 9901 of ARPA. In addition, the department shall ensure that all funds appropriated 34 35 under this act are disbursed in compliance with the Single Audit 36 Act (31 USC Sections 7501-7507) and the related provisions of the Uniform Guidance, 2 CFR Section 200.303 regarding internal 37 38 controls, Sections 200.330 through 200.332 regarding sub-recipient 39 monitoring and management, and subpart F regarding audit 40 requirements.

41 SECTION 3. (1) As a condition of receiving and expending 42 the funds appropriated to the department under this act, the 43 department shall certify to the Department of Finance and 44 Administration that each expenditure of the funds appropriated to

50 (2)If the Office of Inspector General of the United States Department of the Treasury, or the Office of Inspector General of 51 52 any other federal agency having oversight over the use of monies 53 from the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund established by 54 ARPA (a) determines that the department or recipient has expended 55 or otherwise used any of the funds appropriated to the department 56 under this act for any purpose that is not in compliance with the guidelines, guidance, rules, regulations and/or other criteria, as 57 may be amended from time to time, of the United States Department 58 59 of the Treasury regarding the use of monies from the Coronavirus 60 State Fiscal Recovery Fund established by ARPA, and (b) the State 61 of Mississippi is required to repay the federal government for any of those funds that the Office of the Inspector General determined 62 63 were expended or otherwise used improperly by the department or 64 recipient, then the department or recipient that expended or 65 otherwise used those funds improperly shall be required to pay the 66 amount of those funds to the State of Mississippi for repayment to 67 the federal government.

68 **SECTION 4.** The money appropriated by this act shall be paid 69 by the State Treasurer out of any money in the Coronavirus State

No. 1717 **~ OFFICIAL ~** 23/HR31/R2186SG PAGE 3 (RF\JAB) Fiscal Recovery Fund not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his or her warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
