HOUSE BILL NO. 1719 (As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE 2 AND ADMINISTRATION TO ASSIST DESTINATION MARKETING ORGANIZATIONS 3 IN PAYING FOR MARKETING ACTIVITIES, TO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR THE 4 GRAMMY® MUSEUM MISSISSIPPI, AND TO PROVIDE FUNDS TO MISSISSIPPI 5 MAIN STREET ASSOCIATION, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2024. 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much of it as may be 8 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the Coronavirus 9 State Fiscal Recovery Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the 10 Department of Finance and Administration for the purpose of providing funds to destination marketing organizations to assist 11 12 in paying costs of marketing activities, and providing funds to the Grammy® Museum Mississippi to assist in paying certain costs, 13 14 as provided in Section 2 of House Bill No. 419, 2023 Regular 15 Session, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2024\$ 22,000,000.00. 16 17 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much of it as may be 18 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the Coronavirus 19 State Fiscal Recovery Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the

- 20 Department of Finance and Administration for the purpose of
- 21 providing funds to Mississippi Main Street Association as provided
- 22 in Section 57-123-11, for the period beginning upon the passage of
- 23 this act, and ending June 30, 2024.....\$ 3,000,000.00.
- SECTION 3. (1) As used in this section and Section 4 of
- 25 this act, the term "department" means the State Department of
- 26 Health.
- 27 (2) The department shall not disburse any funds appropriated
- 28 under this act to any recipient without first: (a) making an
- 29 individualized determination that the expenditure sought is, in
- 30 the department's independent judgment, for necessary expenditures
- 31 eligible under Section 602 of the federal Social Security Act as
- 32 added by Section 9901 of the federal American Rescue Plan Act of
- 33 2021 (ARPA) and its implementing guidelines, guidance, rules,
- 34 regulations and/or other criteria, as may be amended or
- 35 supplemented from time to time, by the United States Department of
- 36 the Treasury; and (b) determining that the recipient has not
- 37 received and will not receive reimbursement for the expense in
- 38 question from any source of funds, including insurance proceeds,
- 39 other than those funds provided under Section 602 of the federal
- 40 Social Security Act as added by Section 9901 of ARPA. In
- 41 addition, the department shall ensure that all funds appropriated
- 42 under this act are disbursed in compliance with the Single Audit
- 43 Act (31 USC Sections 7501-7507) and the related provisions of the
- 44 Uniform Guidance, 2 CFR Section 200.303 regarding internal

- 45 controls, Sections 200.330 through 200.332 regarding sub-recipient
- 46 monitoring and management, and subpart F regarding audit
- 47 requirements.
- 48 **SECTION 4.** (1) As a condition of receiving and expending
- 49 the funds appropriated to the department under this act, the
- 50 department shall certify to the Department of Finance and
- 51 Administration that each expenditure of the funds appropriated to
- 52 the department under this act complies with the guidelines,
- 53 guidance, rules, regulations and/or other criteria, as may be
- 54 amended from time to time, of the United States Department of the
- 55 Treasury regarding the use of monies from the Coronavirus State
- 56 Fiscal Recovery Fund established by ARPA.
- 57 (2) If the Office of Inspector General of the United States
- 58 Department of the Treasury, or the Office of Inspector General of
- 59 any other federal agency having oversight over the use of monies
- 60 from the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund established by
- 61 ARPA (a) determines that the department or recipient has expended
- 62 or otherwise used any of the funds appropriated to the department
- 63 under this act for any purpose that is not in compliance with the
- 64 guidelines, guidance, rules, regulations and/or other criteria, as
- 65 may be amended from time to time, of the United States Department
- 66 of the Treasury regarding the use of monies from the Coronavirus
- 67 State Fiscal Recovery Fund established by ARPA, and (b) the State
- 68 of Mississippi is required to repay the federal government for any
- 69 of those funds that the Office of the Inspector General determined

- 70 were expended or otherwise used improperly by the department or
- 71 recipient, then the department or recipient that expended or
- 72 otherwise used those funds improperly shall be required to pay the
- 73 amount of those funds to the State of Mississippi for repayment to
- 74 the federal government.
- 75 **SECTION 5.** The money appropriated by this act shall be paid
- 76 by the State Treasurer out of any money in the Coronavirus State
- 77 Fiscal Recovery Fund not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants
- 78 issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer
- 79 shall issue his or her warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 80 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
- 81 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 82 and after its passage, except for Section 1, which shall take
- 83 effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2023.
