## HOUSE BILL NO. 1726

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF LOWNDES
COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, TO CONTRIBUTE FUNDS TO THE YMCA, BOYS AND
GIRLS CLUB, HOMELESS COALITION, UNITED WAY, LAST HOUSE ON THE
BLOCK, HABITAT FOR HUMANITY HOUSING, COMMUNITY COUNSELING, CONTACT
HELPLINE AND HELPING HANDS BY UTILIZING CERTAIN LOCAL FISCAL
RECOVERY FUNDS THAT HAVE BEEN RECEIVED BY THE COUNTY THROUGH THE
AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 9 SECTION 1. (1) The Board of Supervisors of Lowndes County,
- 10 Mississippi, in its discretion, is authorized to expend and
- 11 contribute to certain nonprofit organizations, as authorized under
- 12 this act. The board is authorized to expend and contribute a
- 13 portion of the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds
- 14 of the American Rescue Plan Act that have been allocated to the
- 15 county and converted to revenue loss funds to better assist with
- 16 recovery from the Covid-19 pandemic and to meet specific needs
- 17 within the county.
- 18 (2) Pursuant to subsection (1) of this section, the board of
- 19 supervisors is authorized to expend and contribute such Local
- 20 Fiscal Recovery Funds that have been converted to revenue loss

21	funds to the following organizations, within the county, in
22	amounts not to exceed the following:
23	YMCA\$400,000.00
24	Boys and Girls Club\$175,000.00
25	Homeless Coalition\$200,000.00
26	United Way\$150,000.00
27	Last House on the Block\$175,000.00
28	Habitat for Humanity Housing\$150,000.00

32	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
