- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to Cleveland Stallworth of Jackson County,
- 6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
- 7 conviction on May 30, 1975, in George County for the crime of
- 8 robbery, for which he was sentenced to ten (10) years, sentenced
- 9 on June 22, 1978, in Jackson County for the crime of possession of
- 10 a controlled substance to serve three (3) years concurrent with
- 11 the previous ten (10) year sentence.
- 12 On March 13, 1980, he was convicted of aggravated assault in
- 13 Harrison County for which he was sentenced to three (3) years on
- 14 supervised probation, and convicted of burglary business for which
- 15 he was sentenced to six (6) years probation running consecutive;
- 16 and he was released on April 7, 1987.
- On March 2, 2004, he was convicted for possession of a weapon
- 18 by a convicted felon in Jackson County, and sentenced to serve

- 19 three (3) years, followed by two (2) years supervised probation;
- 20 and discharged on December 28, 2005. On February 8, 2013, he was
- 21 convicted of grand larceny in Jackson County for which he was
- 22 sentenced to serve five (5) years with five (5) years supervised
- 23 probation. He was released on parole and discharged on October
- 24 23, 2015.
- 25 The Legislature is informed that he has conducted himself as
- 26 a law-abiding citizen in a good and lawful manner.
- 27 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 28 and after July 1, 2023.
