HOUSE BILL NO. 1809

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO CLEVELAND  
2 STALLWORTH OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and  
5 completely restored to Cleveland Stallworth of Jackson County,  
6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his  
7 conviction on May 30, 1975, in George County for the crime of  
8 robbery, for which he was sentenced to ten (10) years, sentenced  
9 on June 22, 1978, in Jackson County for the crime of possession of  
10 a controlled substance to serve three (3) years concurrent with  
11 the previous ten (10) year sentence.

12 On March 13, 1980, he was convicted of aggravated assault in  
13 Harrison County for which he was sentenced to three (3) years on  
14 supervised probation, and convicted of burglary business for which  
15 he was sentenced to six (6) years probation running consecutive;  
16 and he was released on April 7, 1987.

17 On March 2, 2004, he was convicted for possession of a weapon  
18 by a convicted felon in Jackson County, and sentenced to serve



19 three (3) years, followed by two (2) years supervised probation;  
20 and discharged on December 28, 2005. On February 8, 2013, he was  
21 convicted of grand larceny in Jackson County for which he was  
22 sentenced to serve five (5) years with five (5) years supervised  
23 probation. He was released on parole and discharged on October  
24 23, 2015.

25 The Legislature is informed that he has conducted himself as  
26 a law-abiding citizen in a good and lawful manner.

27 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
28 and after July 1, 2023.
