HOUSE BILL NO. 1812

- AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO RAHMOND WILLIAMS OF HINDS COUNTY.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to Rahmond Williams of Hinds County,
- 6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
- 7 conviction on February 2, 2009, in Madison County on the charge of
- 8 burglary-vehicle, for which he was sentenced to serve one (1)
- 9 year, and five (5) years supervised probation within the custody
- 10 of the Mississippi Department of Corrections. He was released to
- 11 earned release supervision on October 13, 2009, and discharged on
- 12 November 12, 2009.
- 13 On November 18, 2013, he was convicted in Hinds County on the
- 14 charge of vehicle theft for which he was sentenced to serve three
- 15 (3) years on supervised probation; and on the charge of
- 16 burglary-business for which he was sentenced to serve three (3)
- 17 years of supervised probation to run concurrent with the previous

- 18 convictions within the custody of the Mississippi Department of
- 19 Corrections.
- On February 3, 2014, in Madison County, he was convicted of
- 21 burglary-vehicle, and sentenced to serve six (6) years with
- 22 charges running consecutive to Hinds County sentence previously
- 23 imposed within the Mississippi Department of Corrections. He was
- 24 released to parole on July 20, 2015, and discharged on August 8,
- 25 2017.
- The Legislature is informed that he has since conducted
- 27 himself as a law-abiding citizen in a good and lawful manner.
- 28 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 29 and after its passage.
