HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 14

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING REPRESENTATIVE BENNIE G. 2 THOMPSON FOR HIS OUTSTANDING SERVICE AS CHAIRMAN OF THE UNITED 3 STATES HOUSE SELECT COMMITTEE TO INVESTIGATE THE JANUARY 6, 2021, 4 ATTACK ON THE UNITED STATES CAPITOL. 5 WHEREAS, on January 6, 2021, a mob attacked the United States Capitol in Washington, D.C., and the Capitol Complex was locked 6 7 down and lawmakers and staff were evacuated, while rioters assaulted law enforcement officers, vandalized property and 8 9 occupied the building for several hours; and 10 WHEREAS, on June 30, 2021, the resolution to form the United States House of Representatives Select Committee to Investigate 11 12 the January 6th Attack on the United States Capitol passed by a vote of 222 to 190; and 13 14 WHEREAS, this distinguished committee was tasked to investigate both the security issues of the January 6 attack, as 15 well as the circumstances leading up to the attack; and 16 17 WHEREAS, Representative Bennie G. Thompson from Mississippi, was appointed to serve as chairman of this crucially important 18

19 committee, and Representative Liz Cheney, from Wyoming, was 20 appointed to serve as vice chairman; and

21 WHEREAS, other members of the committee include:

26 WHEREAS, the investigation into the January 6, 2021, event 27 began with public hearings on July 27, 2021, and by the end of 28 November 2021, the committee had interviewed over 250 people; and

29 WHEREAS, Representative Thompson has diligently served, and 30 continues to serve, in his capacity as chairman of this 31 distinguished committee, with dignity, patriotism and respect for 32 the American people; and

33 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize 34 and commend exceptional leaders from Mississippi, especially those 35 such as Representative Thompson, whose dedication and service 36 brings honor to the State of Mississippi and to the United States 37 of America:

38 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF 39 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING 40 THEREIN, That we do hereby commend Representative Bennie G. 41 Thompson for his outstanding service as chairman of the United 42 States House of Representatives Select Committee to Investigate 43 the January 6th Attack on the United States Capitol.
