## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 54

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE 2 CALEDONIA HIGH SCHOOL CAVALIERS VOLLEYBALL TEAM AND HEAD COACH 3 SAMANTHA BROOKS FOR WINNING THEIR FIRST EVER MISSISSIPPI HIGH 4 SCHOOL ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATION CLASS 4A STATE VOLLEYBALL 5 CHAMPIONSHIP. 6 WHEREAS, the Caledonia High School Cavaliers Volleyball Team 7 served victory when they beat Pass Christian High School to win the 2022 Mississippi High School Activities Association (MHSAA) 8

- 9 Class 4A State Volleyball Championship for the first time in
- 10 program history; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the Cavaliers, who had a superior season that was
- 12 driven by more than just the yearning to succeed, intensely
- 13 amplified all of their hard work, motivation and audacity, which
- 14 were so apparent all through the season, for the game that
- 15 ultimately rewarded them with the championship trophy; and
- 16 WHEREAS, aside from a tough start to the first set, the
- 17 Cavaliers cruised their way into a comfortable Set 2 win and a
- 18 comfortable lead in Set 3, up as much as nine points over Pass
- 19 Christian, and the final set scores were 25-20, 25-15 and 25-18,

- 20 as their mental toughness never wavered from the moment the first
- 21 serve was made until the dogpile commenced after the Cavaliers
- 22 sealed their victory; and
- 23 WHEREAS, Set 1 of the state title game felt like both teams
- 24 were trying to feel everything out from the crowd to the court to
- 25 the opponent, and Pass Christian took advantage of some early
- 26 Caledonia mistakes and took an early 8-3 lead off the jump; and
- 27 WHEREAS, Caledonia settled in and cut the Pass Christian lead
- 28 down to 14-13 after an amazing 10-6 run, and from there, the
- 29 Cavaliers had really found their footing and finished the set on a
- 30 10-5 run to take a 1-0 match lead; and
- 31 WHEREAS, a large contingent of Caledonia fans, especially
- 32 students, traveled with the team to the championship series, and
- 33 kept them motivated throughout all three sets, and libero Emma
- 34 McKee had a fantastic service game, as switching up her serve kept
- 35 the other team on their toes; and
- 36 WHEREAS, while Pass Christian was unable to adjust, Caledonia
- 37 was the exact opposite, maturing well into the match, with players
- 38 like Mary Beth Edmondson and Brianna Holliman having great
- 39 offensive games; and
- 40 WHEREAS, Set 3 was an even more exaggerated example of
- 41 success from the Cavaliers, who rode an 8-1 run behind McKee to
- 42 take a commanding 17-9 lead in the set, and they saved a point off
- 43 a kill attempt from the Pass Christian Pirates' outside hitter,
- 44 and when Mary Beth rose up for what Caledonia hoped was the final

- 45 kill, and it tipped off the fingers of a Pirates player and fell
- 46 out of bounds, the point, set and match was awarded to the
- 47 Cavaliers, who immediately made a dogpile on the court in
- 48 celebration of their first ever state title; and
- WHEREAS, the team finished their season with amazing spikes,
- 50 serves and saves by individual players, but the key to the team's
- 51 success each year has been the amazing team spirit and year-round
- 52 hard work; and
- 53 WHEREAS, Head Coach Samantha Brooks has superbly coached and
- 54 inspired the Cavaliers Volleyball Team and broadened their
- 55 knowledge of the game while refining their skills in execution,
- 56 and she continues to build upon the legacy of superior play and
- 57 true sportsmanship forged by the tenacious and undaunted spirit of
- 58 each team member, as evidenced in her ability to produce high
- 59 caliber players and plays and by the team's successful season; and
- 60 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize
- 61 and honor the achievements of student-athletes such as the
- 62 Caledonia High School Cavaliers Volleyball Team, who have brought
- 63 honor to their school, their community, and to the State of
- 64 Mississippi:
