HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 57

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING AND COMMENDING THE
2 MULTITUDE OF CAREER SUCCESSES AND RENOWNED AWARDS BESTOWED UPON
3 DR. DAPHINE G. HILL.

4 WHEREAS, Dr. Daphine G. Hill is a remarkably talented and
5 distinguished individual who currently holds the title and
6 recognition of being an adjunct professor in urban and regional
7 planning at Jackson State University and the Development Director
8 for Boys and Girls Clubs of Central Mississippi; and

9 WHEREAS, after receiving her accounting degree from Millsaps
10 College, Dr. Hill received a master's in political science, a
11 doctor of philosophy degree in planning from Jackson State
12 University and a client executive certification from Harvard
13 University; and

14 WHEREAS, Dr. Hill works in historic preservation and engages
15 her students in "real world" planning projects, and she has
16 attended numerous conferences, including Listen Up Historic
17 Preservation Conferences, Mississippi Heritage Trust Conferences,
18 Urban Affairs Conferences, the National Alliance of Preservation



19 Commissioners Conference, National American Planners Conference,
20 National Historic Preservation Conferences, and Historic
21 Preservation Boot Camps; and

22 WHEREAS, throughout her successful career, Dr. Hill has
23 written several remarkable pieces, including: *The Many Faces of*
24 *Hazlehurst, A History of Hazlehurst, Mississippi*, for which she
25 also produced a video, her dissertation, *Advocating Historic*
26 *Housing Tax Credits to Individuals Who Own And Live in Pre-1960*
27 *Housing to Assist in Alleviating Housing Affordability Crisis in*
28 *Jackson, Mississippi*, and several other prominent and insightful
29 publications; and

30 WHEREAS, Dr. Hill holds membership in the following local,
31 state and national organizations: Mississippi Heritage Trust,
32 Hazlehurst Housing Authority, City of Hazlehurst Mayor's Health
33 Council, We Care Mississippi, Inc., Calling Panther Heritage

47 State University in 2012, selected as the student most
48 representative of Urban and Regional Planning Department at
49 Jackson State University in 2012, the Historic Preservation
50 Diversity Scholar in 2011, member of Jackson State University's Mu
51 Chapter of Alpha Epsilon Lambda National Honor Society; Who's Who
52 Among Students in American Colleges and Universities in 2008,
53 three Golden Circles, three administrative symposiums, two
54 regional manager awards, five technical symposiums and seven 100%
55 Clubs; and
