HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 21

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING CHRISTONE 2 "KINGFISH" INGRAM UPON WINNING HIS FIRST GRAMMY FOR BEST 3 CONTEMPORARY BLUES ALBUM FOR 662 AT THE 64TH ANNUAL GRAMMY AWARDS. 4 WHEREAS, rising star blues guitarist, songwriter and vocalist from Clarksdale, Mississippi, Christone "Kingfish" Ingram, won his 5 first-ever career Grammy Award for Best Contemporary Blues Album 6 for his sophomore release, 662, at the 64th Annual Grammy Awards 7 in Las Vegas, Nevada, on Sunday, April 3, 2022; and 8 9 WHEREAS, at 23 years of age, "Kingfish" has been embraced by the media, which has hailed him for his incendiary guitar playing, 10 11 soulful vocals and memorable songwriting, including Rolling Stone Magazine, which declared him as, "One of the most exciting young 12 guitarists in years, with a sound that encompasses B.B. King, Jimi 13 14 Hendrix and Prince"; and WHEREAS, having previously received a 2019 Grammy Award 15 16 nomination for his debut album Kingfish, Ingram, who just

17 completed the first half of his nationwide 662 Juke Joint Live 18 tour, which included his debut at New York's famed Apollo Theater,

19 noted that the "wow moment" of his unexpected Grammy win was for 20 his late mother, Princess Pride, and for the great State of 21 Mississippi; and

22 WHEREAS, making its world debut on XM/Sirius Radio's B.B. 23 King's Bluesville, *662* was the most-played record on blues radio 24 during 2021 according to Living Blues' annual Radio Airplay Chart; 25 and

26 WHEREAS, one who crafts solos that reflect a mind as quick as 27 his fingers - each note sounds right, each string-bend and 28 grunge-flecked wail appropriate in its place, Ingram's singing is 29 birthed within his soulful and resonant voice, which showcases his 30 musical artistry as a lyric craftsman of depth and substance; and 31 WHEREAS, irrefutably destined for an incredibly bright future 32 of superstardom, Ingram, whose singing and playing is well beyond

33 his years, performed at the massive Byron Bay Bluesfest in 34 Australia, and is scheduled to travel to the United Kingdom and 35 Europe, with dates in England, Scotland, the Netherlands, France 36 and Italy in June and July; and

37 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives to 38 acknowledge the success of such remarkable musical talents as 39 "Kingfish," whose reimagined expansive interpretation of the blues 40 has garnered him much acclaim and solidifies the fact that 41 Mississippi remains the birthplace of America's music: 42 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF 43 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby

44 commend and congratulate Christone "Kingfish" Ingram, upon winning 45 his first-ever career Grammy Award for Best Contemporary Blues 46 Album at the 64th Annual Grammy Awards, and extend most sincere 47 wishes for continued success in all his future endeavors.
