HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 33

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE SCOTT CENTRAL
2 "REBELS" FOOTBALL TEAM AND HEAD COACH JEFF STOCKSTILL FOR WINNING
3 BACK-TO-BACK MISSISSIPPI HIGH SCHOOL ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATION (MHSAA)
4 CLASS 2A STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS.

5 WHEREAS, whatever the Scott Central High School "Rebels"
6 Football Team left on the field in last season's 72-24 win in the
7 2021 MHSAA Class 2A State Championship Game, it picked up in this
8 year's title clash with Charleston High School in a decisive 42-12
9 victory on December 3, 2022, and the Rebels finished a complete
10 effort to back-to-back Class 2A State Championships; and

11 WHEREAS, the Rebels had a remarkable season that was driven
12 by more than just the yearning to succeed, intensely amplified all
13 of their hard work, motivation and audacity, led by an electric
14 offense during its eight-game regular season winning streak,
15 averaging 41 points per game, while being guided on the field
16 under the passionate perseverance of Senior Austin Goss, who
17 amassed 2,531 passing yards, 509 rushing yards and 43 touchdowns
18 in 13 games; and



19 WHEREAS, in the Championship game, Scott Central (13-2)
20 wasted no time getting into the end zone with quarterback Quez
21 Goss launching a 50-yard touchdown pass to Antreyvious Edwards on
22 the second play of the game; and

23 WHEREAS, after allowing a touchdown on the opening drive,
24 Scott Central's defense locked down, and on the Rebels' third
25 possession, Goss unleashed his unbridled talent, finding Javieon
26 Butler for a 73-yard touchdown, complimented by a 31-yard
27 touchdown pass to Edwards on the ensuing drive; and

28 WHEREAS, Butler and Edwards, both classified Seniors,
29 combined for eight catches, 264 yards and five touchdowns in the
30 first half en route to a 35-6 lead at halftime, with the defensive
31 line veiling the field with an impenetrable steel curtain, which
32 only allowed Charleston to finish its last six first-half drives
33 with a punt; and

34 WHEREAS, with the latest consecutive state championships for
35 the 2021 and 2022 gridiron seasons, the Rebels now have four State
36 Championships dating back to 2018 and 1999 on display in the
37 school's trophy case; and

38 WHEREAS, the Scott Central statistics were impressive, and
39 there were outstanding performances by individual players, but the
40 key to this team's consistent success has been the constant team
41 atmosphere and year-round hard work; and

42 WHEREAS, Head Coach Cody Jeff Stockstill and his
43 exceptionally talented staff of assistant coaches have superbly



44 coached and inspired the Rebels and broadened their knowledge of
45 the game while refining their skills in execution, and continue to
46 build upon the legacy of superior play and true sportsmanship
47 forged by the tenacious and undaunted spirit of each team member,
48 as evidenced in the coaching staff's ability to produce high
49 caliber players and plays and by the team's successful season; and
