HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 84

1 A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING AND COMMENDING MRS. SARAH LEA ANGLIN
2 UPON BEING NAMED THE 2022 STATE GAMES OF MISSISSIPPI FEMALE
3 ATHLETE OF THE YEAR.

4 WHEREAS, Mrs. Sarah Lea Anglin, a mountain biker from
5 Madison, Mississippi, has been named the 2022 State Games of
6 Mississippi Female Athlete of the Year, a truly exceptional
7 accomplishment; and

8 WHEREAS, Mrs. Anglin has been participating in this
9 distinguished sport for three years, during which she won a gold
10 medal in the 2022 State Games Mountain Bike event; and

11 WHEREAS, though this year's mountain bike course was the
12 hardest Mrs. Anglin has ever completed, she still found it to be
13 "really fun"; and

14 WHEREAS, outside of the State Games, Mrs. Anglin has many
15 achievements, such as placing in the 2021 Gulf South Regional
16 Mountain Bike Series, the 2022 Oak Mountain Race, the 2022 Tux
17 Creek Tussle Race and the Tuffburg Race; and



18 WHEREAS, outstandingly, Mrs. Anglin was inspired to take up
19 mountain biking because of her young granddaughter, as she and her
20 husband had been mentors in the Mississippi Kids Cyclocross
21 Program, when her granddaughter said, "Why don't you race?", and
22 though her first thought was, "I'm going to die!", her second
23 thought was, "I have to do this. These girls need to see someone
24 out there riding and racing – giving it their best. Why not a
25 grandmother?"; and

26 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives to
27 recognize extraordinary Mississippians, especially those such as
28 Mrs. Anglin, whose hard work and dedication to the sport of
29 mountain biking brings honor to the State of Mississippi:

30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
31 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby
32 recognize and commend Mrs. Sarah Lea Anglin upon being named the
33 2022 State Games of Mississippi Female Athlete of the Year, and
34 express our most sincere wishes for continued success in all her
35 future endeavors.
