HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 115

1 A RESOLUTION ENCOURAGING FURTHER ECONOMIC TIES AND FRIENDSHIP 2 BETWEEN THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI AND THE REPUBLIC OF CHINA 3 (TAIWAN).

WHEREAS, the longstanding bonds of friendship between the
United States and the Republic Of China (Taiwan), embodied in the
Taiwan Relations Act of 1979, continue to yield important
economic, social, strategic, and cultural benefits; and
WHEREAS, the Republic Of China (Taiwan) ranks as the United

9 States' 9th largest trading partner with bilateral trade reaching 10 \$114 billion and the 6th largest export market for United States 11 agricultural products in 2021; and

12 WHEREAS, the robust trade and investment partnership between 13 the United States and the Republic Of China (Taiwan) provides a 14 solid foundation for a mutually beneficial bilateral trade 15 agreement (BTA) to spur job creation, further expand the global 16 market, and secure international supply chains; and

WHEREAS, the Republic Of China (Taiwan) is committed to helping address global challenges, from humanitarian crises to

19 nontraditional security threats, and it has emerged as an 20 important partner in pandemic prevention, bolstering unprecedented 21 international support for its bid to participate in the World 22 Health Assembly (WHA); and

23 WHEREAS, Taiwanese officials and civil society groups partner 24 with the United States on a range of issues to promote our common 25 values of freedom, democracy and human rights, building on the 26 cooperative tradition of prior joint partnerships such as the 27 Global Cooperation and Training Framework (GCTF), which advances 28 Taiwanese leadership in such arenas as democratization, human 29 rights, women's empowerment, and public health; and

30 WHEREAS, the promotion of freedom and democracy is the strong 31 glue that provides the unshakable bond between the Republic Of 32 China (Taiwan) and the United States of America; and

33 WHEREAS, since 1983, Mississippi and the Republic Of China 34 (Taiwan) have maintained a sister-state relationship and enjoy 35 particularly close economic ties, as it is the Magnolia State's 36 5th largest export partner in Asia, with over \$32 million in goods 37 and services to the Republic Of China (Taiwan) in 2021; and

38 WHEREAS, the establishment of a Mississippi Trade and 39 Investment Office in the Republic Of China (Taiwan) could enhance 40 the participation of small and medium-sized enterprises in trade 41 and investment, and advance sister-state ties between Mississippi 42 and the Republic Of China (Taiwan); and

43 WHEREAS, Mississippi and the United States have benefited 44 immeasurably through decades of unwavering friendship with the 45 Republic Of China (Taiwan), and the wider world is sure to reap 46 tremendous rewards as the Republic Of China (Taiwan) works to 47 enhance its presence in the international community:

48 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby 49 50 express our support for the strengthening of our partnership with 51 the Republic Of China (Taiwan) and for the expansion of its role 52 on the global stage; support a bilateral trade agreement between 53 the United States and the Republic Of China (Taiwan); support the Republic Of China's (Taiwan) participation in the Indo-Pacific 54 55 Economic Framework for Prosperity (IPEFP); support the Republic Of 56 China's (Taiwan) meaningful participation in the World Health 57 Assembly and other international organizations such as ICAO and 58 the UNFCCC; support a Mississippi Trade and Investment Office in 59 the Republic Of China (Taiwan); celebrate the 44th anniversary of the enactment of the Taiwan Relations Act, and the 40th 60 61 anniversary of the sister-state relationship between the State of 62 Mississippi and the Republic Of China (Taiwan).
