## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 169

A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING AND COMMENDING ANGIE THOMAS UPON HER ACCOMPLISHMENTS AS AN AUTHOR, PRODUCER, SPEAKER, ACTIVIST AND PHILANTHROPIST.

4 WHEREAS, while Angie Thomas has been a Mississippi rising

5 star, as a native of Jackson, Mississippi, a graduate of Belhaven

6 University and as a former teen rapper, the world came to know

7 this Magnolia Princess and literary prodigy, after she was named

8 the inaugural winner of the Walter Dean Myers Grant 2015, awarded

9 by We Need Diverse Books, for her 2017 debut novel, The Hate U

10 Give, which was birthed out of her collegiate senior project; and

11 WHEREAS, holding a bachelor of fine arts degree in creative

12 writing and an unofficial degree in "hip hop," Ms. Thomas, who now

13 resides between Mississippi and Georgia, The Hate U Give was later

14 acquired by the Balzer+Bray imprint of HarperCollins Publishers in

15 a 13-publisher auction and debuted at Number 1 on the New York

16 Times bestseller list, winning the American Library Association's

17 William C. Morris Debut Award, the Boston Globe-Horn Book Award

- 18 (USA), the Waterstones Children's Book Prize (UK) and the
- 19 Deutscher Jugendliteraturpreis (Germany); and
- 20 WHEREAS, The Hate U Give, written to bring light to the
- 21 controversial issue of police brutality and the Black Lives Matter
- 22 movement, was adapted into a critically acclaimed film from Fox
- 23 2000 in 2018, starring Amandla Stenberg and directed by George
- 24 Tillman, Jr.; and
- 25 WHEREAS, subjected to multiple instances of gun violence at a
- 26 young age, Ms. Thomas, who was born and raised in Jackson, and who
- 27 grew up near the home of assassinated civil rights activist Medgar
- 28 Evers, was inspired to take up writing after her mother took her
- 29 to the library to expose her to the limitless possibilities the
- 30 world offered following the dreadful event of having witnessed a
- 31 shootout at only six years of age; and
- 32 WHEREAS, initially poised to write fantasy and middle grade
- 33 novels, Ms. Thomas's 2019 sophomore novel, On the Come Up, is
- 34 currently a Number 1 New York Times bestseller as well, keeping on
- 35 trend with the success of The Hate U Give, with a film development
- 36 with Paramount Pictures in the works, which will afford Ms. Thomas
- 37 her breakout role as a producer; and
- 38 WHEREAS, quite the workaholic with an unyielding pen to give
- 39 voice to those who have been permanently silenced through
- 40 misconceived acts of aggression, as well as those who endure the
- 41 horrors produced by the stinging reality of a loved one's life
- 42 being senselessly and prematurely extinguished, Ms. Thomas

43	released Find Your Voice: A Guided Journal to Writing Your Truth,
44	as a tool to help aspiring writers tell their stories, followed by
45	a 2021 return to the world of Garden Heights with the publication
46	of Concrete Rose, a prequel to The Hate U Give, which debuted at
47	Number 1 on the New York Times bestseller list, and Blackout, a
48	collaborative collection of stories with a central theme of Black
49	teen love expressed during a New York City power outage; and
50	WHEREAS, Ms. Thomas views her writing as her means of
51	activism by making "something that is so political seem personal";
52	and
53	WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives to
54	highlight the successes of our state's native sons and daughters
55	who have immersed themselves in arts and literature to inspire the
56	next generation of talent, as evidenced by Ms. Thomas's litany of
57	literary achievements:
