- 21 sealed their victory; and
- 22 WHEREAS, Set 1 of the state title game felt like both teams
- 23 were trying to feel everything out from the crowd to the court to
- 24 the opponent, and Pass Christian took advantage of some early
- 25 Caledonia mistakes and took an early 8-3 lead off the jump; and
- 26 WHEREAS, Caledonia settled in and cut the Pass Christian lead
- 27 down to 14-13 after an amazing 10-6 run, and from there, the
- 28 Cavaliers had really found their footing and finished the set on a
- 29 10-5 run to take a 1-0 match lead; and
- 30 WHEREAS, a large contingent of Caledonia fans, especially
- 31 students, traveled with the team to the championship series, and
- 32 kept them motivated throughout all three sets, and libero Emma
- 33 McKee had a fantastic service game, as switching up her serve kept
- 34 the other team on their toes; and
- 35 WHEREAS, while Pass Christian was unable to adjust, Caledonia
- 36 was the exact opposite, maturing well into the match, with players
- 37 like Mary Beth Edmondson and Brianna Holliman having great
- 38 offensive games; and
- 39 WHEREAS, Set 3 was an even more exaggerated example of
- 40 success from the Cavaliers, who rode an 8-1 run behind McKee to
- 41 take a commanding 17-9 lead in the set, and they saved a point off
- 42 a kill attempt from the Pass Christian Pirates' outside hitter,
- 43 and when Mary Beth rose up for what Caledonia hoped was the final
- 44 kill, and it tipped off the fingers of a Pirates player and fell

- 45 out of bounds, the point, set and match was awarded to the
- 46 Cavaliers, who immediately made a dogpile on the court in
- 47 celebration of their first ever state title; and
- 48 WHEREAS, the team finished their season with amazing spikes,
- 49 serves and saves by individual players, but the key to the team's
- 50 success each year has been the amazing team spirit and year-round
- 51 hard work; and
- 52 WHEREAS, Head Coach Samantha Brooks has superbly coached and
- 53 inspired the Cavaliers Volleyball Team and broadened their
- 54 knowledge of the game while refining their skills in execution,
- 55 and she continues to build upon the legacy of superior play and
- 56 true sportsmanship forged by the tenacious and undaunted spirit of
- 57 each team member, as evidenced in her ability to produce high
- 58 caliber players and plays and by the team's successful season; and
