HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 173

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE MOST HONORABLE AND DISTINGUISHED
2 GENTLEMAN FROM HARRISON, REPRESENTATIVE RANDALL H. PATTERSON, FOR
3 HIS ESTEEMED AND LAUDABLE LEGISLATIVE CAREER AND PUBLIC SERVICE
4 UPON THE SPECIAL OCCASION OF HIS RETIREMENT FROM THE MISSISSIPPI
5 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

6 WHEREAS, the honorable and distinguished Gentleman from
7 Harrison, Representative Randall H. Patterson, has announced his
8 plans for retirement from the Mississippi House of Representatives
9 at the conclusion of the 2023 Regular Session of the Mississippi
10 Legislature, after 20 years of tirelessly working on behalf of the
11 citizens of District 115; and

12 WHEREAS, a resident and native of Biloxi, Mississippi,
13 Representative Patterson, who even as a young person was on the
14 trajectory of greatness that would eventually lead to his
15 representing District 115, graduated from Biloxi High School
16 before attending Mississippi Gulf Coast Community College (MGCCC);

18 WHEREAS, blessed with God-given talents, Representative
19 Patterson played baseball at the Perkinston campus of the college



20 and was vital in the team's winning the Mississippi Association of
21 Junior Colleges Championship both years he played; and

22 WHEREAS, Representative Patterson, after graduating from
23 MGCCC in 1968, furthered his education by earning a bachelor's
24 degree from the University of Southern Mississippi, the renowned
25 home of the Golden Eagles, in 1971, and later earned a double
26 master's degree in physical education and school administration
27 from William Carey University in 1979; and

28 WHEREAS, before being elected to District 115 by his fellow
29 citizens, Representative Patterson worked alongside his father,
30 A.H. "Lank" Patterson, at their family's mechanical contracting
31 company until being elected in 2004; and

32 WHEREAS, upon his election to the House of Representatives,
33 Randall H. Patterson became the distinguished Gentleman from
34 Harrison and wasted no time requesting the legislation, amendments
35 and reports that would help effectuate into law the ideologies and
36 policy changes that his constituents along the Mississippi Gulf
37 Coast had elected him to carry out, and notably, not long after
38 coming to the House, he helped guide and ensure that his
39 constituents received the aid that was needed post Hurricane
40 Katrina; and

41 WHEREAS, during his tenure as a legislator, Representative
42 Patterson has effectively served as Chairman of Investigate State
43 Offices Committee, and Vice Chairman of the Ports, Harbors and
44 Airports Committee, and he also served, throughout his prestigious



45 tenure, as a member of the Enrolled Bills; Executive Contingent
46 Fund; Constitution; Marine Resources; Oil, Gas and Other Minerals;
47 Public Property; Tourism; Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks; Gaming;
48 Universities and Colleges; Juvenile Justice; Banking and Financial
49 Services and Ways and Means Committees; and

50 WHEREAS, not one to limit his community involvement to the
51 Legislature, Representative Patterson, a contractor by profession,
52 has always been active in District 115 and has been dedicated to
53 improving the quality of life for all citizens, as evidenced by
54 his service and affiliations as a member of the American
55 Legislative Exchange Council, Biloxi Chamber of Commerce, Biloxi
56 Bay Chamber of Commerce, Association of General Contractors of
57 Mississippi, City of Biloxi Plumbing and Mechanical Board and the
58 Biloxi Elks' Lodge #606 - all of which are a testament of his part
59 of ensuring the Mississippi Gulf Coast continues to thrive; and

60 WHEREAS, the members of the House of Representatives will
61 cherish the bond and common goals for the betterment of this great
62 state shared with Representative Patterson over the course of the
63 past 20 years, and his impeccable service was unparalleled in the
64 Mississippi Legislature and to the constituents of District 115;

66 WHEREAS, Representative Patterson has remained a phenomenal
67 gentleman, grounded in his integrity, who seeks to improve the
68 lives of others through positive example, hard work and the
69 undeniable truths of the Word of God; and



70 WHEREAS, the service of Representative Patterson would be
71 without honor but for the continued support, encouragement and
72 love of his beautiful wife, Vickie, and their children, Grant and
73 Randi, who have endured the daunting struggles that accompany the
74 life of an elected official, and much credit is also due to his
75 loved ones who sacrificed countless hours without him in order to
76 allow him to fulfill his legislative obligations; and

77 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives to
78 honor the indelible legacy of remarkable service of our colleague
79 and friend, Representative Randall H. Patterson, who fearlessly
80 represented District 115, this body and the people of this state
81 with honor and intrepid dignity:

83 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby
84 commend the most honorable, distinguished Gentleman from Harrison,

86 legislative career and public service, and express fondest respect
87 and best wishes for continued success in all his future endeavors
88 on the beautiful Mississippi Gulf Coast and beyond.
