HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 194

1           A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE INGOMAR  
2 ATTENDANCE CENTER LADY FALCONS BASKETBALL TEAM AND HEAD COACH  
3 TRENT ADAIR FOR WINNING THE MISSISSIPPI HIGH SCHOOL ACTIVITIES  
4 ASSOCIATION (MHSAA) 2023 CLASS 1A STATE CHAMPIONSHIP.

5           WHEREAS, in a season of firsts, the Ingomar Attendance Center  
6 Lady Falcons Basketball Team reached the ultimate milestone after  
7 a whirlwind championship bout at the "Big House" against their  
8 well-contended opponent and defending Class 1A champs, the  
9 Biggersville Lady Lions, whom they ousted in a sweeping 53-38  
10 victory, to claim the 2023 Mississippi High School Activities  
11 Association State Championship; and

12           WHEREAS, throughout the state tournament games, the Lady  
13 Falcons played with clear eyes, full hearts and unimaginable  
14 amounts of strength, and in each game, their mental stamina and  
15 athletic prowess never wavered from the moment they first hustled
