HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 205

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE MOST HONORABLE, DISTINGUISHED 2 GENTLEMAN FROM MADISON, REPRESENTATIVE JOEL BOMGAR, FOR HIS 3 ESTEEMED LEGISLATIVE CAREER AND PUBLIC SERVICE UPON THE OCCASION OF HIS RETIREMENT FROM THE MISSISSIPPI HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES. 5 WHEREAS, the honorable and distinguished Gentleman from Madison, Representative Joel Bomgar, has announced his plans to 6 7 retire from the Mississippi House of Representatives at the conclusion of his current term, after tirelessly working on behalf 8 9 of the citizens of Mississippi and House District 58, which 10 encompasses Madison County, for eight outstanding years; and WHEREAS, before assuming his seat as a member of the House of 11 12 Representatives in 2016, Representative Bomgar, a 2003 graduate of Belhaven University, founded Bomgar Corporation (now BeyondTrust), 13 14 while working his way through college as a systems engineer, and created the concept for his company's remote support product, the 15 Bomgar Box, as a way to provide helpdesk and technical support to 16 17 disparate users without leaving his desk, and as the company expanded and flourished, it remained focused on its Madison County 18

- 19 roots as one of the largest employers in the Madison/Ridgeland
- 20 area; and
- 21 WHEREAS, additionally, during his six years of service in the
- 22 Mississippi Air National Guard, Representative Bomgar honed his
- 23 networking and computer skills, and earned numerous network
- 24 certifications, along with the Air Force Achievement Medal and the
- 25 Air Force Commendation Medal; and
- 26 WHEREAS, after his election to the House of Representatives
- 27 in 2015, Representative Bomgar became the distinguished "Gentleman
- 28 from Madison" upon being sworn into office on the first day of his
- 29 first legislative session in January 2016, and he embraced being
- 30 in the Legislature like he does everything else, with exuberant
- 31 energy, and wasted no time requesting the drafting of legislation,
- 32 amendments and reports to try to enact into law the policies that
- 33 his constituents had elected him to pursue and promote; and
- 34 WHEREAS, during his time in the House, Representative Bomgar
- 35 served as Vice Chairman of the Medicaid Committee from 2016 until
- 36 2020, Vice Chairman of the Drug Policy Committee from 2020 until
- 37 2024, and as a member of numerous other committees, such as: Ways
- 38 and Means; Corrections; Education; Judiciary B; Judiciary En Banc;
- 39 Municipalities; Public Property; Technology; Youth and Family
- 40 Affairs; and Accountability, Efficiency and Transparency; and
- 41 WHEREAS, the primary issue with which Representative Bomgar
- 42 is most associated, and about which he was most passionate during
- 43 his legislative career, is medical marijuana, and the very first

44	bill that he introduced as a freshman member in 2016 was to create
45	a medical marijuana pilot program; and there was little interest
46	in passing such a bill at that time, but when he reintroduced his
47	bill in 2017 and 2018, more members were introducing their own
48	bills on the subject, and the support for authorizing medical
49	marijuana kept growing, which led to the overwhelming approval of
50	a constitutional initiative that legalized medical marijuana; and
51	while the initiative was struck down by the state Supreme Court
52	the following year, the Legislature responded during the 2022
53	session and enacted the Mississippi Medical Cannabis Act, which
54	was the realization of Representative Bomgar's ambitious goal when
55	he introduced his first bill; and
56	WHEREAS, Representative Bomgar, who always wears a bright
57	orange tie to reflect the color used by his company, is a string
58	bean of energy who moves so quickly his edges nearly blur, and
59	with a strong work ethic, positive, energetic disposition, and
60	unrelenting tenacity, throughout his eight years in the
61	Legislature, Representative Bomgar has had a pertinacious focus
62	and unshakable drive to boldly serve his constituents, even if
63	doing so presented as going against the grain of the majority; and
64	WHEREAS, not one to limit his community involvement to the
65	Legislature, Representative Bomgar is an advocate for economic
66	growth and developmental efforts in Madison County, and dedicated
67	to improving the quality of life for all citizens, as evidenced by
68	his service and affiliation as Honorary Chairman of the Hazlitt

- 69 Coalition of Young Americans for Liberty, the founder of Out of
- 70 Last Place Institute in Mississippi, a member of the Steering
- 71 Council of Mississippi Economic Council's Blueprint Mississippi,
- 72 and a former board member of the Madison County Foundation and of
- 73 his alma mater, Belhaven University; and
- 74 WHEREAS, outside of his exceptional legislative service,
- 75 Representative Bomgar is the president of Próspera, an economic
- 76 development platform enabling sustainable, profitable growth in
- 77 partnership with governments and communities, empowering modern
- 78 pioneers to contribute to a new generation of flourishing cities
- 79 by partnering with community leaders, experts and firms across
- 80 various sectors to provide the knowledge, capital, connections,
- 81 infrastructure, services, and security needed for sustainable
- 82 economic development; and
- 83 WHEREAS, the service of Representative Bomgar would be
- 84 without honor but for the continued support, encouragement and
- 85 love of his family, who have endured the difficulties that
- 86 accompany the life of an elected official, and much credit is
- 87 certainly due to his loved ones who have sacrificed countless
- 88 hours without him in order to allow him to fulfill his legislative
- 89 obligations, including his wife, Rachel, and their children,
- 90 Amelia, Simon, Mark and Seth; and
- 91 WHEREAS, one of Representative Bomgar's favorite Bible
- 92 verses, Psalm 127:1, states "Unless the Lord builds the house,

93 those who build it labor in vain", and he believes that exceller	nce

- 94 should be the hallmark of every Christian; and

- 96 honor the stellar service of public servants such as our colleague
- 97 and friend, Joel Bomgar, who represented his district, this body
- 98 and the people of this state with honor and dignity:

- 101 commend the Gentleman from Madison, Representative Joel Bomgar,
- 102 for his esteemed legislative career and public service, and
- 103 express best wishes for continued success in all his future
