SENATE BILL NO. 2002
(As Passed the Senate)

1 AN ACT TO DESIGNATE A SEGMENT OF UNITED STATES HIGHWAY 45 IN
2 LOWNDES COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, AS THE "PFC BRADFORD C. FREEMAN
3 MEMORIAL HIGHWAY" IN MEMORY OF DECEASED WORLD WAR II ARMY VETERAN
4 PRIVATE FIRST CLASS BRADFORD CLARK FREEMAN; TO DESIGNATE A SECTION
5 OF INTERSTATE 220 NORTH IN HINDS COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, AS THE
6 "SENATOR DOUGLAS ANDERSON MEMORIAL HIGHWAY" IN HONOR OF FORMER
7 MISSISSIPPI SENATOR DOUGLAS ANDERSON; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

9 **SECTION 1.** (1) The section of Mississippi Highway 45 North
10 located in Lowndes County, Mississippi, beginning at the Ridge
11 Road Exit near Kolola Springs, Mississippi, and extending one (1)
12 mile north is designated and shall be known as the "PFC Bradford
13 C. Freeman Memorial Highway" in memory of deceased World War II
14 army veteran Private First Class Bradford Clark Freeman of
15 Caledonia, Mississippi.

16 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
17 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching the segment
18 of highway described in subsection (1) of this section.

19 **SECTION 2.** (1) The section of Interstate 220 North located
20 in Hinds County, Mississippi, beginning at the Highway 49



21 intersection in Jackson, Mississippi, and extending north for one
22 (1) mile, is designated and shall be known as the "Senator Douglas
23 Anderson Memorial Highway" in honor of former Mississippi Senator
24 Mr. Douglas Anderson of Jackson, Mississippi.

25 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
26 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching the segment
27 of highway described in subsection (1) of this section.

28 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
29 and after July 1, 2023, and shall stand repealed on June 30, 2023.
