SENATE BILL NO. 2003

1 AN ACT TO DESIGNATE A SEGMENT OF MISSISSIPPI HIGHWAY 12 IN
2 OKTIBBEHA COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, AS THE "G. LOUIS JONES MEMORIAL
3 HIGHWAY" IN MEMORY OF THE LATE FORMER POLICE CHIEF GRANVEL LOUIS
4 JONES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 **SECTION 1.** (1) The section of Mississippi Highway 12
7 located in Oktibbeha County, Mississippi, beginning at
8 Sturgis-Maben Road in Sturgis, Mississippi, and extending one (1)
9 mile east to Sturgis-Louisville Road in Sturgis, Mississippi, is
10 designated and shall be known as the "G. Louis Jones Memorial
11 Highway" in memory of the late former Police Chief Granvel Louis
12 Jones of Oktibbeha, Mississippi.

13 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
14 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching the segment
15 of highway described in subsection (1) of this section.

16 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
17 and after its passage.
