SENATE BILL NO. 2049

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-3-9, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE A STATUTORY LIMITATION ON THE SALARY OF THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC EDUCATION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 37-3-9, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 37-3-9. (1) There shall be a State Superintendent of Public
- 8 Education who shall be appointed by the State Board of Education,
- 9 with the advice and consent of the Senate, and serve at the
- 10 board's will and pleasure. He shall be the Chief Administrative
- 11 Officer for the State Department of Education and shall administer
- 12 the department in accordance with the policies established by the
- 13 State Board of Education. The State Superintendent of Education,
- 14 serving on July 1, 2011, shall continue to receive the salary that
- 15 he was receiving on January 1, 2011. From and after the
- 16 completion of the term of the said superintendent serving on July
- 17 1, * * * 2022, the salary of the State Superintendent of Education
- 18 shall be established by the State Board of Education, but not to

- 19 exceed one hundred five percent (105%) of the national average for
- 20 state superintendents as published by the Southern Regional
- 21 Education Board (SREB). The State Superintendent of Public
- 22 Education shall have at least a master's degree in any field and a
- 23 minimum of five (5) years' experience in administration in the
- 24 educational field.
- 25 (2) The State Superintendent shall give bond in the penalty
- of Seventy-five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000.00), with sureties to be
- 27 approved by the Governor, conditioned according to law. The bond,
- 28 when approved, shall be filed and recorded in the Office of the
- 29 Secretary of State.
- 30 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 31 and after July 1, 2023.
