SENATE BILL NO. 2060

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 73-27-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
REVISE THE DEFINITION OF PODIATRIC MEDICINE TO INCLUDE TREATMENT
OF THE FOOT AND ANKLE AND THEIR GOVERNING AND RELATED STRUCTURES;
TO REVISE THE DEFINITION OF PODIATRIST TO MEAN A PHYSICIAN WHO
ENGAGES IN THE PRACTICE OF PODIATRIC MEDICINE; AND FOR RELATED
PURPOSES.

- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 **SECTION 1.** Section 73-27-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 9 amended as follows:
- 10 73-27-1. (1) The practice of podiatric medicine is that
- 11 profession concerned with the prevention, examination, diagnosis
- 12 and medical, surgical and adjuvant treatment of conditions of the
- 13 human foot and ankle, and their governing and related structures,
- 14 including the muscles or tendons of the lower leg governing the
- 15 functions of the foot and ankle. * * *
- 16 (2) A podiatrist is a * * * physician who engages in the
- 17 practice of podiatric medicine.
- 18 (3) A podiatrist may prescribe and administer drugs and
- 19 tests, excluding general and spinal anesthesia, that are essential
- 20 to the practice of podiatric medicine when used for or in

- 21 connection with treatment of disorders of the human foot and
- 22 ankle, and their governing and related structures, including the
- 23 muscles or tendons of the lower leg governing the functions of the
- 24 foot and ankle.
- 25 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 26 and after July 1, 2023.
