- 9 **SECTION 1.** Section 45-9-131, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

- 14 system \* \* \* may be allowed to purchase, as his or her personal

- 16 officer by the law enforcement agency from which he or she retired
- 17 or by whom he or she was employed at the time of death. \* \* \*
- 18 (2) Upon approval of the director of a state agency, board
