SENATE BILL NO. 2145

- AN ACT TO CREATE NEW SECTION 17-25-37, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROHIBIT ANY LOCAL ORDINANCE THAT WOULD LEGALIZE CAMPING ON STREETS, ROADS AND SIDEWALKS OR ANY OTHER PUBLIC PROPERTY; TO AMEND SECTIONS 97-35-23 AND 97-35-25, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CLARIFY THE PROHIBITION ON CAMPING ON PUBLIC SIDEWALKS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 **SECTION 1.** The following shall be codified as Section
- 9 17-25-37, Mississippi Code of 1972:
- 10 17-25-37. (1) Neither the board of supervisors of any
- 11 county nor the governing authority of any municipality shall
- 12 adopt, enact or enforce any ordinance authorizing camping on
- 13 streets, roads, sidewalks or any other public property.
- 14 (2) For the purposes of this section, the term "public
- 15 property" does not mean any government-owned or operated state,
- 16 local or federal campground, recreational campground or other such
- 17 facility where camping is an authorized activity.
- 18 **SECTION 2.** Section 97-35-23, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 19 amended as follows:

- 20 97-35-23. (1) It shall be unlawful for any person or
- 21 persons to intentionally obstruct, or interfere with the normal or
- 22 ordinary free use and passage of vehicles of or on, any public
- 23 street or highway provided for use by vehicular traffic, or for
- 24 any person or persons to intentionally obstruct, or interfere with
- 25 the normal or ordinary free use and passage of pedestrians of or
- 26 on any public sidewalk provided for foot travel by pedestrians,
- 27 including camping on a public sidewalk, and any person or persons
- 28 who do so * * * shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon
- 29 conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than
- 30 Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00), or by imprisonment in the county
- 31 jail for not more than four (4) months, or by both such fine and
- 32 imprisonment.
- 33 (2) The provisions of this section are supplementary to the
- 34 provisions of any other statute of this state.
- 35 **SECTION 3.** Section 97-35-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 36 amended as follows:
- 97-35-25. (1) It shall be unlawful for any person or
- 38 persons to \star \star willfully obstruct the free, convenient and
- 39 normal use of any public sidewalk, street, highway, alley,
- 40 road * * * or other passageway by camping on the sidewalk or
- 41 impeding, hindering, stifling, retarding or restraining traffic or
- 42 passage thereon, and any person or persons violating the
- 43 provisions of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and
- 44 upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more

- 45 than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or by confinement in the
- 46 county jail not exceeding six (6) months, or by both such fine and
- 47 imprisonment.
- 48 (2) The provisions of this section are supplementary to the
- 49 provisions of any other statute of this state.
- 50 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 51 and after July 1, 2023.
