## SENATE BILL NO. 2149

- 1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE CITY OF 2 GUNTOWN, MISSISSIPPI, TO ALLOW THE OPERATION OF SIDE-BY-SIDE 3 VEHICLES ON CERTAIN PUBLIC ROADS AND STREETS WITHIN THE CITY; TO
- REQUIRE INDIVIDUALS OPERATING A SIDE-BY-SIDE VEHICLE TO HAVE A
- 5 VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE AND PROOF OF INSURANCE; TO REQUIRE
- 6 SIDE-BY-SIDE VEHICLES TO BE REGISTERED WITH THE CITY; TO AUTHORIZE 7 THE CITY TO CHARGE A REGISTRATION FEE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 9 SECTION 1. As used in this act, unless a different meaning
- clearly appears in the context, the following terms shall have the 10
- 11 following meanings:
- 12 (a) "City" means the City of Guntown, Mississippi.
- (b) "Governing authorities" means the Mayor and Board 13
- 14 of Aldermen of the city.
- 15 (c) "Side-by-side vehicle" means a four-wheeled,
- 16 motorized vehicle designed for off-road use and equipped with
- lights, blinkers, seat belts, a horn, and a two-passenger front 17
- 18 seat.
- 19 **SECTION 2.** (1) The governing authorities may, in their
- discretion, by ordinance, authorize the operation of side-by-side 20

- 21 vehicles only on public roads and streets in the city. The
- 22 authorization must be embodied in an ordinance and recorded on the
- 23 minutes of the Board of Aldermen. The authorization may be
- 24 accompanied by conditions not inconsistent with this act and may
- 25 be revoked, in whole or in part, by the governing authorities at
- 26 any time.
- 27 (2) Any person operating a side-by-side vehicle on the
- 28 public roads and streets in the city under this act must have in
- 29 his or her possession a valid driver's license from this state or
- 30 another state and proof of insurance, including at least Fifty
- 31 Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) of liability insurance, and follow
- 32 the applicable requirements of Section 63-15-1 et seq.,
- 33 Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 34 **SECTION 3.** (1) Any person operating a side-by-side vehicle
- 35 as authorized under this act on a public road or street shall be
- 36 required to register the vehicle with the city. The owner of the
- 37 side-by-side vehicle shall be issued a registration decal by the
- 38 city that must be displayed as determined by the city. The
- 39 registration shall remain valid for as long as the registering
- 40 owner owns the side-by-side vehicle.
- 41 (2) The city may, by ordinance, establish a registration fee
- 42 for side-by-side vehicles. The registration fee shall be retained
- 43 by the city clerk and deposited into the municipal general fund.
- 44 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 45 and after its passage.
