AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 19-23-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, CLARIFY THAT A COUNTY PROSECUTING ATTORNEY MAY DEFEND ANY PERSON IN ANY CRIMINAL PROSECUTION NOT WITHIN THE COUNTY IN WHICH HE OR SHE IS THE COUNTY PROSECUTING ATTORNEY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 19-23-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

8 amended as follows:

9 19-23-13. The county prosecuting attorney shall not

10 represent or defend any person in any criminal prosecution in the name of the state, county or municipality of the county, nor shall 11 12 he or she give any advice against the state, his or her county or in a criminal case against a municipality of his or her county, 13 and shall not represent any person in any case against the state, 14 15 his or her county, or in a criminal case arising in a municipal court of his or her county. Nothing herein shall prohibit any 16 county prosecuting attorney from defending any person in any 17 criminal prosecution in any county not within the * * * county in 18 19 which he or she is the county prosecuting attorney.
