SENATE BILL NO. 2233

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 45-9-131, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO AUTHORIZE THE NEXT OF KIN OF A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER KILLED 3 IN THE LINE OF DUTY TO PURCHASE THE OFFICER'S SIDEARM; AND FOR 4 RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Section 45-9-131, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 7 amended as follows: 8 45-9-131. (1) (a) Upon approval of the governing authority 9 of the municipality or county, a member of any municipal or county 10 law enforcement agency who retires under any state retirement system \* \* \*, the spouse of a law enforcement officer who is 11 12 killed in the line of duty or the next of kin of an unmarried law 13 enforcement officer who is killed in the line of duty may be 14 allowed to purchase as his or her personal property one (1) sidearm which was issued to the law enforcement officer by the law 15 16 enforcement agency from which he or she retired or by whom he or 17 she was employed at the time of death. (b) If a married officer is killed in the line of duty 18 19 and the officer's spouse declines to purchase the officer's

## 20 <u>sidearm, the officer's next of kin may be allowed to purchase the</u> 21 officer's sidearm.

22 (2) The governing authority of the municipality or county 23 shall determine the amount to be paid for the firearm by the 24 retiring member of the law enforcement agency **\* \* \***, the spouse of 25 the law enforcement officer <u>or the next of kin of the law</u> 26 enforcement officer.

## 27 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
