No disqualification from voting shall be imposed as a condition of 10 parole, probation, or any outstanding fines or fees. 11 12 Upon release from prison, a person must be given an (b) 13 official document which provides: 14 (i) That the person has been released from prison; 15 (ii) That the person is restored to the civil 16 right to vote; and 17 (iii) A description of how to register to vote.
