- 1 AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 443, LAWS OF 2022, TO AUTHORIZE THE 2 MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION AND THE
- MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF ARCHIVES AND HISTORY TO ADD A PARCEL OF
- LAND KNOWN AS "THE OLD MAGNOLIA CHURCH" TO THE CHAMPION HILL
- 5 HISTORICAL PROPERTY WHICH WAS DELETED FROM THE LEGAL DESCRIPTION
- 6 IN ERROR AND WHICH IS BEING TRANSFERRED TO THE JURISDICTION OF THE
- 7 NATIONAL PARK SERVICE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 9 SECTION 1. Section 1, Chapter 443, Laws of 2022, is amended
- 10 as follows:

- Administration, acting on behalf of the Mississippi Department of 12
- 13 Archives and History, is authorized to donate to the U.S.
- 14 Department of the Interior, National Park Service, Vicksburg
- National Military Park all the rights, title and interest in 15
- 16 certain real property under the possession and control of the
- Department of Archives and History, located in the Second Judicial 17
- 18 District of Hinds County, Mississippi, subject to the requirements
- and conditions prescribed in subsection (3) of this section. Upon 19
- 20 completing a field survey, the Department of Finance and

21	Administration, acting on behalf of the Mississippi Department of
22	Archives and History, is authorized to develop a legal description
23	and file necessary deeds to exclude a two-hundred-foot buffer to
24	extend southerly from the existing south right-of-way line of the
25	railroad property, thereby forming the north line of the National
26	Park Service property at the Champion Hill Battlefield property
27	described below, and to describe an access corridor to be retained
28	by the Mississippi Department of Archives and History. The
