SENATE BILL NO. 2328

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 27-104-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
TO EXEMPT THE MISSISSIPPI ADEQUATE EDUCATION PROGRAM FROM MID-YEAR
BUDGET REDUCTIONS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 27-104-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 27-104-13. (1) The State Fiscal Officer may disapprove or
- 8 reduce and revise the estimates of general funds and state-source
- 9 special funds for any general fund or special fund agency and for
- 10 the "administration and other expenses" budget of the Mississippi
- 11 Department of Transportation and the Office of State Aid Road
- 12 Construction, in an amount not to exceed five percent (5%), if at
- 13 any time he finds that funds will not be available within the
- 14 period for which the budget is drawn, or if at any time he finds
- 15 that the requested expenditures, or any part thereof, are not
- 16 authorized by law, and that action shall be reported to the
- 17 Legislative Budget Office.



18	The State Fiscal Officer may, upon his determination of need
19	based upon a finding that funds will not be available within the
20	period for which the budget is drawn, transfer funds as provided
21	in Section 27-103-203, from the Working Cash-Stabilization Reserve
22	Fund to the General Fund to supplement the general fund revenue.
23	If the estimates of general funds and state-source special
24	funds of all general fund and special fund agencies and of the
25	"administration and other expenses" budget of the Mississippi
26	Department of Transportation and the Office of State Aid Road
27	Construction have been reduced by five percent (5%), additional
28	reductions may be made, but shall consist of a uniform percentage
29	reduction of general funds and state-source special funds to all
30	general fund and special fund agencies and to the "administration
31	and other expenses" budget of the Mississippi Department of
32	Transportation and the Office of State Aid Road Construction.
33	Any state-source special funds reduced under the provisions
34	of this subsection (1) shall be transferred to the State General
35	Fund upon requisitions for warrants signed by the respective
36	agency head, and the transfer shall be made within a reasonable
37	period to be determined by the State Fiscal Officer.
38	The provisions of this subsection (1) authorizing the State
39	Fiscal Officer to disapprove or reduce and revise the estimates of
40	general funds and state-source special funds for the
41	"administration and other expenses" budget of the Mississippi
42	Department of Transportation and the Office of State Aid Road

- 43 Construction shall be suspended during the period from June 30,
- 44 2009, through June 30, 2010.
- The Department of Revenue and University Research 45
- Center, utilizing all available revenue forecast data, shall 46
- 47 annually develop a general fund revenue estimate to be adopted by
- 48 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee as of the date of sine die
- adjournment. If, at the end of October, or at the end of any 49
- 50 month thereafter of any fiscal year, the revenues received for the
- 51 fiscal year fall below ninety-eight percent (98%) of the general
- 52 fund revenue estimate adopted by the Joint Legislative Budget
- Committee at the date of sine die adjournment, the State Fiscal 53
- 54 Officer shall reduce allocations of general funds and state-source
- 55 special funds to general fund and special fund agencies and to the
- 56 "administration and other expenses" budget of the Mississippi
- 57 Department of Transportation and the Office of State Aid Road
- 58 Construction, in an amount necessary to keep expenditures within
- 59 the sum of actual general fund receipts, including any transfers
- to the General Fund from the Working Cash-Stabilization Reserve 60
- 61 Fund for the fiscal year.
- 62 The State Fiscal Officer may, upon his determination of need
- 63 based on the revenue shortfall, transfer funds as provided in
- 64 Section 27-103-203 from the Working Cash-Stabilization Reserve
- Fund to the General Fund to supplement the general fund revenue. 65
- 66 State-source special funds in an amount equal to any reduction
- made under the provisions of this subsection (2) shall be 67

- 69 warrants signed by the respective agency head, and the transfer
- 70 shall be made within a reasonable period to be determined by the
- 71 State Fiscal Officer.
- No agency's allocation shall be reduced in an amount to
- 73 exceed five percent (5%); however, if the allocations of general
- 74 funds and state-source special funds to all general fund and
- 75 special fund agencies and to the "administration and other
- 76 expenses" budget of the Mississippi Department of Transportation
- 77 and the Office of State Aid Road Construction have been reduced by
- 78 five percent (5%), any additional reductions required to be made
- 79 under this subsection (2) shall consist of a uniform percentage
- 80 reduction of general funds and state-source special funds to all
- 81 general fund and special fund agencies and to the "administration
- 82 and other expenses" budget of the Mississippi Department of
- 83 Transportation and the Office of State Aid Road Construction. Any
- 84 receipt from loans authorized by Sections 31-17-101 through
- 85 31-17-123 shall not be included as revenue receipts.
- The State Fiscal Officer shall immediately send notice of any
- 87 action taken under authority of this subsection (2) to the
- 88 Legislative Budget Office.
- 89 The provisions of this subsection (2) requiring the State
- 90 Fiscal Officer to reduce allocations of general funds and
- 91 state-source special funds to general fund and special fund
- 92 agencies and to the "administration and other expenses" budget of

95 For the purpose of this section, the term "state-source special funds" means any special funds in any agency derived from 96 97 any source, but shall not include the following special funds: 98 special funds derived from federal sources, from local or regional political subdivisions, from agricultural commodity assessments, 99 100 or from donations; special funds derived from additional fees paid 101 for the issuance of distinctive motor vehicle license tags or plates authorized under the provisions of Chapter 19, Title 27, 102 103 Mississippi Code of 1972; special funds held in a fiduciary 104 capacity for the benefit of specific persons or classes of 105 persons; special funds of the Mississippi Veterans Affairs Board 106 that are paid to the board by the veteran residents of state veterans homes to fund their monthly expenses at the state 107 108 veterans homes; self-generated special funds of the state 109 institutions of higher learning or the state community or junior colleges; special funds of Mississippi Industries for the Blind, 110 111 the State Port at Gulfport, Yellow Creek Inland Port, Pat Harrison 112 Waterway District, Pearl River Basin Development District, Pearl 113 River Valley Water Management District, Tombigbee River Valley 114 Water Management District, Yellow Creek Watershed Authority, or Coast Coliseum Commission; special funds of the Department of 115 116 Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks and the Department of Marine Resources derived from the issuance of hunting or fishing 117

118	licenses; and special funds generated by agencies whose primary
119	function includes the establishment of standards and the issuance
120	of licenses for the practice of a profession within the State of
121	Mississippi. The Mississippi School of the Arts established in
122	Section 37-140-1 et seq., the Mississippi School for the Blind and
123	Deaf established in Section 43-5-1 et seq., and the Mississippi
124	School for Mathematics and Science established in Section 37-139-1
125	et seq., shall be subject to any mid-year budget revisions or
126	reductions imposed by the State Fiscal Officer under this section
127	only to the same extent as is applicable to other school districts
128	in the state. Funds allocated for the Mississippi Adequate
129	Education Program shall be exempt from any budget reductions
130	required under this section.
131	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after July 1, 2023.
