COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE SENATE BILL NO. 2343

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 45-1-19, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO INCLUDE THE GOVERNOR'S MANSION WITHIN THE LIST OF STATE-OWNED BUILDINGS OVER WHICH THE OFFICE OF CAPITOL POLICE HAS JURISDICTION; TO PROVIDE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY 5 SHALL HAVE JURISDICTION RELATIVE TO THE ENFORCEMENT OF ALL LAWS OF 6 THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF 7 JACKSON, MISSISSIPPI; TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND THE CITY OF JACKSON TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF 8 9 UNDERSTANDING BY A CERTAIN DATE; TO REQUIRE THE WRITTEN 10 AUTHORIZATION OF THE CHIEF OF THE CAPITOL POLICE OR THE 11 COMMISSIONER PRIOR TO THE APPROVAL OF ANY EVENT WHICH IS TO TAKE 12 PLACE ON ANY STREET OR SIDEWALK IMMEDIATELY ADJACENT TO ANY 13 BUILDING OR PROPERTY OWNED OR OCCUPIED BY ANY OFFICIAL, AGENCY, 14 BOARD, COMMISSION, OFFICE OR OTHER ENTITY OF THE STATE OF 1.5 MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 16 17 SECTION 1. Section 45-1-19, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 18 19 45-1-19. (1) The Department of Public Safety, through the

Office of Capitol Police, shall have jurisdiction relative to the

sidewalks and leased parking lots within the Capitol Complex, set

forth in Section 29-5-2, the Governor's Mansion, the Court of

- 25 Appeals Building, the Mississippi Department of Transportation
- 26 Building and the Public Employees' Retirement System Building, and
- 27 any property purchased, constructed or otherwise acquired by the
- 28 State of Mississippi for conducting state business and not
- 29 specifically under the supervision and care by any other state
- 30 entity, but which is reasonably assumed the Department of Public
- 31 Safety would be responsible for such. The Department of Public
- 32 Safety shall, through any person or persons appointed by the
- 33 commissioner, make arrests for any violation of any law of the
- 34 State of Mississippi on the grounds of or within those properties.
- 35 The Department of Public Safety shall, in addition, enforce the
- 36 provisions of this section and Sections 29-5-57 through 29-5-67,
- 37 29-5-73 through 29-5-75, and 29-5-81 through 29-5-95, and
- 38 prescribe such rules and regulations as are necessary therefor.
- 39 The powers and duties related to the administration of Sections
- 40 29-5-57 through 29-5-67, 29-5-73 through 29-5-75, and 29-5-81
- 41 through 29-5-95 shall remain with the Department of Finance and
- 42 Administration.
- 43 (2) Subject to the approval of the Board of Trustees of
- 44 State Institutions of Higher Learning, the Board of Trustees and
- 45 the Department of Public Safety shall be authorized to enter into
- 46 a contract for the Department of Public Safety to supply the
- 47 security personnel with jurisdiction to enforce all laws of the
- 48 State of Mississippi on the property of the Board of Trustees

- 49 located at the corner of Ridgewood Road and Lakeland Drive in the
- 50 City of Jackson.
- 51 (3) The Department of Public Safety and the Department of
- 52 Agriculture are authorized to enter into a contract for the
- 53 Department of Public Safety to have jurisdiction and enforce all
- 54 laws of the State of Mississippi on the property of the Department
- of Agriculture located at 121 North Jefferson Street and the new
- 56 Farmers Market Building located at the corner of High and
- 57 Jefferson Streets in the City of Jackson, Hinds County,
- 58 Mississippi. It is the intent of the Legislature that the
- 59 Department of Public Safety will not post any security personnel
- 60 at such buildings, but will provide regular vehicle patrols and
- 61 responses to security system alarms.
- 62 (4) The Department of Public Safety and the Mississippi Fair
- 63 Commission are authorized to enter into a contract for the
- 64 Department of Public Safety to have jurisdiction and enforce all
- 65 laws of the State of Mississippi on the property of the
- 66 Mississippi Fair Commission known as the "Mississippi State
- 67 Fairgrounds Complex" and any and all of its outlying buildings and
- 68 property. The Department of Public Safety and the Mississippi
- 69 Fair Commission are authorized to enter into a contract for the
- 70 Department of Public Safety to supply the security personnel to
- 71 the Mississippi Fair Commission with jurisdiction to enforce all
- 72 laws of the State of Mississippi on this property and any and all
- 73 buildings on this property.

- 74 (5) The Department of Public Safety and the Department of
- 75 Revenue are authorized to enter into a contract for the Department
- 76 of Public Safety to supply the security personnel with
- 77 jurisdiction to enforce all laws of the State of Mississippi at
- 78 the Alcoholic Beverage Control facility and the Department of
- 79 Revenue main office.
- 80 (6) The Department of Public Safety shall have jurisdiction
- 81 relative to the enforcement of all laws of the State of
- 82 Mississippi within the boundaries of the Capitol Complex
- 83 Improvement District created in Section 29-5-203. The Department
- 84 of Public Safety shall have jurisdiction relative to the
- 85 enforcement of all laws of the State of Mississippi within the
- 86 boundaries of the City of Jackson, Mississippi. The Department of
- 87 Public Safety shall, through any person or persons appointed by
- 88 the Department of Public Safety, make arrests for any violation of
- 89 any law of the State of Mississippi which occurs within the
- 90 boundaries of the district and the City of Jackson. The
- 91 jurisdiction of the Department of Public Safety granted under this
- 92 subsection (6) shall be concurrent with the jurisdiction of the
- 93 City of Jackson, Mississippi, and that of Hinds County,
- 94 Mississippi. The Commissioner of the Department of Public Safety
- 95 and City of Jackson shall enter into a Memorandum of Understanding
- 96 by January 30, 2024, which shall be mutually beneficial to both
- 97 parties detailing the expectations of both parties. The execution
- 98 of or failure to execute such a memorandum shall not affect any

- 99 grant of jurisdiction under this subsection. At any time and/or 100 during any event necessitating the coordination of and/or utilization at multiple jurisdictions, as determined by the Chief 101 102 of Capitol Police or the Commissioner, the Department of Public 103 Safety shall be the lead agency when the event occurs on property 104 as defined herein that is owned or leased by the state as provided in subsection (1) of this section. Written authorization of the 105 106 Chief of the Capitol Police or the Commissioner shall be required 107 prior to the approval of any event which is to take place on any street or sidewalk immediately adjacent to any building or 108 109 property owned or occupied by any official, agency, board, 110 commission, office or other entity of the State of Mississippi, or 111 which can reasonably be expected to block, impede or otherwise 112 hinder ingress thereto and/or egress therefrom. The jurisdiction 113 and authority of the Department of Public Safety under this 114 subsection (6) shall be in addition to any other jurisdiction and 115 authority provided to the department under this section or any 116 other law.
- 117 (7) The Department of Public Safety is authorized to enter
 118 into a contract with any county for the county to take custody of
 119 the misdemeanor offenders arrested under the authority granted
 120 under this section.
- 121 (8) All accrued personal leave earned pursuant to Section 122 25-3-93, accrued major medical leave earned pursuant to Section 123 25-3-95, accrued state compensatory leave earned pursuant to

- 127 for all employees transferred under this section.
- 128 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 129 and after January 1, 2024.
