 SALARIES AS EQUALLY RANKED SWORN LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS OF THE

- 9 **SECTION 1.** Section 45-1-12, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

- 12 Mississippi Highway Safety Patrol who have completed the course of
- 13 instruction in an authorized highway patrol training school on
- 14 general law enforcement, and are serving as a sworn officer of the
- 15 Highway Patrol in the enforcement of the laws of the State of
- 16 Mississippi, including service in any other division of the
- 17 Department of Public Safety, and the sworn law enforcement
- 18 officers of the Mississippi Bureau of Narcotics, shall be
- 19 determined and paid in accordance with the scale for officers
- 20 salaries as provided in this subsection:
