## COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 2352

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 23-15-753, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,

2	TO PENALIZE ANY PERSON WHO FRAUDULENTLY REQUESTS OR SUBMITS AN APPLICATION FOR ABSENTEE BALLOTS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. Section 23-15-753, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
6	amended as follows:
7	23-15-753. (1) Any person who willfully, knowingly,
8	unlawfully and feloniously procures, seeks to procure, or seeks to
9	influence the vote of any person voting by absentee ballot, by the
10	payment of money, the promise of payment of money, or by the
11	delivery of any other item of value or promise to give the voter
12	any item of value, or by promising or giving the voter any favor
13	or reward in an effort to influence his vote, or any person who
14	aids, abets, assists, encourages, helps, or causes any person
15	voting an absentee ballot to violate any provision of law
16	pertaining to absentee voting, or any person who sells his vote
17	for money, favor, or reward, has been paid or promised money, a
18	reward, a favor or favors, or any other item of value, or any

- 19 person who fraudulently and knowingly requests or submits an
- 20 absentee ballot, or any person who shall willfully swear falsely
- 21 to any affidavit provided for in Sections 23-15-621 through
- 22 23-15-735, shall be guilty of the crime of "vote fraud" and, upon
- 23 conviction, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Five
- 24 Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) nor more than Five Thousand Dollars
- 25 (\$5,000.00), or by imprisonment in the county jail for no more
- 26 than one (1) year, or by both fine and imprisonment, or by being
- 27 sentenced to the State Penitentiary for not less than one (1) year
- 28 nor more than five (5) years.
- 29 (2) It shall be unlawful for any person who pays or
- 30 compensates another person for assisting voters in marking their
- 31 absentee ballots to base the pay or compensation on the number of
- 32 absentee voters assisted or the number of absentee ballots cast by
- 33 persons who have received the assistance. Any person who violates
- 34 this section, upon conviction, shall \* \* \* be fined not less than
- 35 One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) nor more than Five Thousand
- 36 Dollars (\$5,000.00), or imprisoned in the Penitentiary not less
- 37 than one (1) year nor more than five (5) years, or both.
- 38 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 39 and after July 1, 2023.
