COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 2352

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 23-15-753, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO PENALIZE ANY PERSON WHO FRAUDULENTLY REQUESTS OR SUBMITS AN 3 APPLICATION FOR ABSENTEE BALLOTS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 23-15-753, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5 amended as follows: 6 7 23 - 15 - 753. (1) Any person who willfully, knowingly, unlawfully and feloniously procures, seeks to procure, or seeks to 8 9 influence the vote of any person voting by absentee ballot, by the 10 payment of money, the promise of payment of money, or by the 11 delivery of any other item of value or promise to give the voter any item of value, or by promising or giving the voter any favor 12 13 or reward in an effort to influence his vote, or any person who 14 aids, abets, assists, encourages, helps, or causes any person 15 voting an absentee ballot to violate any provision of law 16 pertaining to absentee voting, or any person who sells his vote for money, favor, or reward, has been paid or promised money, a 17 18 reward, a favor or favors, or any other item of value, or any

20 absentee ballot, or any person who shall willfully swear falsely to any affidavit provided for in Sections 23-15-621 through 21 22 23-15-735, shall be quilty of the crime of "vote fraud" and, upon 23 conviction, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Five 24 Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) nor more than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), or by imprisonment in the county jail for no more 25 26 than one (1) year, or by both fine and imprisonment, or by being 27 sentenced to the State Penitentiary for not less than one (1) year 28 nor more than five (5) years.

29 (2) It shall be unlawful for any person who pays or compensates another person for assisting voters in marking their 30 31 absentee ballots to base the pay or compensation on the number of 32 absentee voters assisted or the number of absentee ballots cast by 33 persons who have received the assistance. Any person who violates 34 this section, upon conviction, shall \* \* \* be fined not less than 35 One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) nor more than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), or imprisoned in the Penitentiary not less 36 37 than one (1) year nor more than five (5) years, or both.

38 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 39 and after July 1, 2023.
