## SENATE BILL NO. 2362

- AN ACT TO CREATE NEW SECTION 37-3-109, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO RESPOND TO ANY REQUEST FOR INFORMATION FROM A MEMBER OF THE SENATE OR HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES WITH THE REQUESTED INFORMATION WITHIN SEVEN DAYS OF SUCH REQUEST; TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT TO ENSURE IT HAS PROPER STAFFING TO RESPOND TO SUCH REQUESTS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 **SECTION 1.** The following shall be codified as Section
- 9 37-3-109, Mississippi Code of 1972:
- 10 37-3-109. The Department of Education shall promptly respond
- 11 to any request for information from a member of the Senate or
- 12 House of Representatives. A member of the Senate or House of
- 13 Representatives may request any information within the Department
- 14 of Education's purview, including but not limited to, education
- 15 programs, school statistics, employee salaries, school success,
- 16 funding mechanisms or grant information. The Department of
- 17 Education shall provide the requested information within seven (7)
- 18 days of such request. The Department of Education shall ensure it
- 19 has proper staffing to respond to such requests.

- 20 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 21 and after July 1, 2023.
