SENATE BILL NO. 2419

1 AN ACT TO ENACT THE EASE ACCESS TO SUFFRAGE (EASE) ACT; TO 2 ESTABLISH THE EASE ACCESS TO SUFFRAGE PROGRAM WITHIN THE EXTERNAL 3 AFFAIRS DIVISION OF THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE; TO PROVIDE THAT THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM SHALL BE TO PUBLISH THE 4 CRITERIA FOR THE RESTORATION OF SUFFRAGE IN MISSISSIPPI, TO CREATE 5 6 A PUBLIC PORTAL FOR APPLICATIONS, TO RAISE AWARENESS ABOUT THE 7 SUFFRAGE PROCESS AND TO ENSURE THAT THAT A PERSON'S RIGHT TO VOTE IS FULLY RESTORED FOR THE NEXT ELECTION AFTER THE RESTORATION OF 8 THE RIGHT BY THE LEGISLATURE UNDER ARTICLE 12, SECTION 253 OF THE 9 MISSISSIPPI CONSTITUTION OF 1890; TO SET FORTH CERTAIN CRITERIA 10 FOR THE RESTORATION OF THE RIGHT TO SUFFRAGE; TO REQUIRE THE 11 12 DIVISION TO CREATE A PUBLIC PORTAL FOR APPLICATIONS; TO REQUIRE 13 THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE TO RAISE AWARENESS OF THE PROGRAM THROUGH A MEDIA CAMPAIGN; TO REQUIRE THE SECRETARY OF 14 15 STATE TO COORDINATE WITH CERTAIN MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATURE IN 16 DETERMINING THE CRITERIA FOR THE RESTORATION OF SUFFRAGE AND THE 17 PROGRAM; TO AUTHORIZE THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE TO 18 PROMULGATE RULES OR REGULATIONS TO ADMINISTER THIS SECTION; TO 19 REQUIRE THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE TO PROMULGATE CLEAR 20 RULES AND REGULATIONS TO ENSURE THAT A PERSON'S RIGHT TO VOTE IS FULLY RESTORED FOR THE NEXT ELECTION AFTER THE RESTORATION OF 21 22 SUFFRAGE UNDER ARTICLE 12, SECTION 253 OF THE MISSISSIPPI 23 CONSTITUTION OF 1890; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

25 SECTION 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the

26 "Ease Access to Suffrage Act" or the "EASE Act."

27 SECTION 2. As used in this act, the following terms shall 28 have the meaning herein ascribed unless the context clearly 29 requires otherwise: 30 "Department" means the Office of the Secretary of (a) 31 State. 32 (b) "Division" means the External Affairs Division 33 within the department. 34 "Program" means the Ease Access to Suffrage Program (C) 35 established in Section 3 of this act. 36 "Suffrage bill" means a bill that restores the (e) 37 right to vote of a person who was disenfranchised. 38 The Ease Access to Suffrage Program is **SECTION 3.** (1) 39 established within the External Affairs Division of the 40 department. The purpose of the program shall be to: 41 (2)Publish the criteria for the restoration of 42 (a) 43 suffrage in Mississippi; 44 Create a public portal for applications; (b) 45 Raise awareness about the suffrage process; and (C) 46 Ensure that that a person's right to vote is fully (d) 47 restored for the next election after the restoration of suffrage by the Legislature under Article 12, Section 253 of the 48 Mississippi Constitution of 1890. 49 50 **SECTION 4.** The published criteria within the program shall include, but not be limited to: 51

52 (a) How long an individual should be released from the 53 custody of the Department of Corrections before requesting the 54 filing of a suffrage bill;

55 (b) The required information for the drafting of a 56 suffrage bill;

57 (c) The proof of payment on fines, fees, or restitution 58 if needed;

59 (d) The proof of any completed programs of60 rehabilitation if needed; and

61 (e) Other criteria as required by the Mississippi
62 Constitution or either chamber of the Legislature.

63 <u>SECTION 5.</u> (1) The program shall include a public portal 64 for applications from persons to the Legislature for the 65 restoration of the right of suffrage. The public portal shall 66 regularly update an applicant on the status of the application, to 67 include its acceptance or rejection.

68 (2) It shall be the duty of an applicant to retain a member
69 of the Mississippi House of Representatives or the Mississippi
70 Senate to sponsor a suffrage bill under the program.

(3) Suffrage bills shall be prepared and drafted by the Legislative Services Offices of either the House or the Senate. The division may prepare a draft of a suffrage bill as part of the portal to be used in the preparation and drafting of the actual suffrage bill.

79 <u>SECTION 6.</u> The department shall raise awareness of the 80 program via a media campaign on one or more public facing 81 platforms to include, but not be limited to, a website, social 82 media platforms or a newspaper.

83 <u>SECTION 7.</u> In establishing the criteria for suffrage bills 84 and the rules and regulations required by subsection (2) of 85 Section 8 of this act, the Secretary of State shall coordinate 86 with the Lieutenant Governor, the Speaker of the House, the Chairs 87 the Senate Judiciary, Division B Committee, the Senate Elections 88 Committee, the House Judiciary B Committee and the House 89 Apportionment and Elections Committee.

90 <u>SECTION 8.</u> (1) The department shall have the authority to 91 promulgate rules or regulations to administer this section.

92 (2) The department shall promulgate clear rules and 93 regulations to ensure that a person's right to vote is fully 94 restored for the next election after the restoration of suffrage 95 under Article 12, Section 253 of the Mississippi Constitution of 96 1890.

97 **SECTION 9.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 98 and after July 1, 2023.
