- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** If any candidate for a statewide office receives
- 7 a majority of the votes cast for such office in the general
- 8 election, that candidate shall be declared elected. If no
- 9 candidate for such office receives a majority of the votes cast
- 10 for such office in the general election, the names of the two (2)
- 11 candidates receiving the highest number of votes for such office
- 12 shall be placed on the ballot for a second election to be held
- 13 three (3) weeks later in accordance with appropriate procedures
- 14 followed in other elections involving runoff candidates.
- 15 **SECTION 2.** Section 1 of this act shall be codified in Title
- 16 23, Chapter 15, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 17 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 18 and after July 1, 2023.
