## SENATE BILL NO. 2483

- AN ACT TO CREATE THE MISSISSIPPI STATE EMPLOYEE MATERNITY LEAVE ACT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** (1) This section shall be known and may be cited
- 5 as the "Mississippi State Employee Maternity Leave Act."
- 6 (2) For the purposes of this section, the following words
- 7 and phrases shall have the following meanings ascribed, unless the
- 8 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 9 (a) "Maternity" means the birth of a child to a
- 10 pregnant mother and the custody of and care for that infant child
- 11 in its first six months of life.
- 12 (b) "Eligible beneficiary" means a state employee, as
- 13 defined in Section 25-3-91(c), who has given birth to a child.
- 14 (c) "Paid leave" means leave from work at the
- 15 employee's full rate of pay.
- 16 (3) The state shall offer to all eligible beneficiaries at
- 17 least six (6) months of paid leave for maternity purposes. An

- 18 eligible beneficiary may only use such leave continuously and
- 19 within six (6) months of the birth of the child.
- 20 (4) Nothing in this section shall be construed as requiring
- 21 an eligible beneficiary to use the leave offered to them, nor
- 22 shall this section be construed as abrogating or otherwise
- 23 modifying the provisions of Section 25-3-95(9).
- SECTION 2. Section 1 of this act shall be codified in Title
- 25 25, Chapter 3, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 26 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 27 and after July 1, 2023.
