SENATE BILL NO. 2531

AN ACT TO DESIGNATE A SEGMENT OF INTERSTATE 55 SOUTH IN HINDS COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, AS THE "REP. ALYCE CLARKE MEMORIAL HIGHWAY" IN HONOR OF MISSISSIPPI HOUSE REPRESENTATIVE ALYCE CLARKE; TO AMEND SECTION 65-3-38.1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO ALLOW HIGHWAYS, ROADS, STREETS OR BRIDGES IN THE DESIGNATED STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM TO BE NAMED AFTER ELECTED OFFICIALS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. (1) The section of Interstate 55 South located 9 10 in Hinds County, Mississippi, beginning at the County Line Road in 11 Jackson, Mississippi, and extending approximately six (6) miles 12 south to Fortification Street in Jackson, Mississippi, is 13 designated and shall be known as the "Rep. Alyce Clarke Memorial 14 Highway" in honor of Mississippi House Representative Ms. Alyce Clarke of Yazoo City, Mississippi. 15

16 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
17 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching the segment
18 of highway described in subsection (1) of this section.

## SECTION 2. Section 65-3-38.1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows:

21 65-3-38.1. \* \* \* ( \* \* \*1) No legislation shall be enacted 22 by the Legislature naming any highway, road, street or bridge on 23 the designated state highway system after any person unless the governing body of each county and municipality where the highway, 24 25 road, street or bridge is located duly adopts a resolution 26 requesting the Legislature to enact such legislation and files a 27 certified copy of such resolution with the Chairman of the Senate or House Committee to which such legislation is referred. 28

29 (\*\*\* $\underline{2}$ ) The provisions of this section shall not apply to 30 Sections 65-7-151 and 65-7-153.

31 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 32 and after July 1, 2023.
