SENATE BILL NO. 2560

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-16-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT IF A SCHOOL DISTRICT REQUIRES STUDENTS TO COMPLETE A MISSISSIPPI HISTORY COURSE TO GRADUATE THEN IT SHALL DEVELOP A PROCEDURE FOR STUDENTS WHO TRANSFERRED INTO THE DISTRICT FROM A DISTRICT THAT DID NOT REQUIRE SUCH COURSE; TO REQUIRE ALTERNATIVE OPPORTUNITIES TO TAKE THE COURSE FOR FRESHMEN, SOPHOMORES AND JUNIORS; TO REQUIRE DISTRICTS TO INCLUDE ALTERNATIVE COURSES THAT MAY BE SUBSTITUTED FOR THE MISSISSIPPI HISTORY COURSE FOR PURPOSE OF GRADUATION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 11 **SECTION 1.** Section 37-16-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 12 amended as follows:
- 13 37-16-7. (1) Each district school board shall establish
- 14 standards for graduation from its schools which shall include as a
- 15 minimum:
- 16 (a) Mastery of minimum academic skills as measured by
- 17 assessments developed and administered by the State Board of
- 18 Education.
- 19 (b) Completion of a minimum number of academic credits,
- 20 and all other applicable requirements prescribed by the district
- 21 school board.

- 23 rates. High schools with graduation rates lower than eighty
- 24 percent (80%) must submit a detailed plan to the Mississippi
- 25 Department of Education to restructure the high school experience
- 26 to improve graduation rates.
- 27 (2) A student who meets all requirements prescribed in
- 28 subsection (1) of this section shall be awarded a standard diploma
- 29 in a form prescribed by the State Board of Education.
- 30 (3) The State Board of Education may establish student
- 31 proficiency standards for promotion to grade levels leading to
- 32 graduation.
- 33 (4) If a school district requires students to complete a
- 34 Mississippi History course to graduate then the district shall
- 35 develop a procedure for students who transferred into the district
- 36 from a district that did not require such course. For freshmen,
- 37 sophomores and juniors who transfer into such a district, the
- 38 school district shall notify the student of an alternative
- 39 opportunity to take the Mississippi History course, including, but
- 40 not limited to, an online class or in-person summer school class.
- 41 Such districts shall include alternative courses that may be
- 42 substituted for the Mississippi History course for purposes of
- 43 graduation for seniors who transfer into such a district.
- 44 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 45 and after July 1, 2023.
