## SENATE BILL NO. 2593

- AN ACT TO CREATE NEW SECTION 37-125-9, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT JACKSON STATE UNIVERSITY SHALL CONSTRUCT A 3 SIX HUNDRED ROOM STUDENT HOUSING PROJECT FOR ALL ELIGIBLE STUDENTS; TO PROVIDE THAT STUDENTS MAY BE HOUSED IN SUCH HOUSING 5 PROJECT ON A FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED BASIS OR BY ANY OTHER LEGAL 6 PROCEDURE ESTABLISHED BY JACKSON STATE UNIVERSITY; TO PROVIDE THAT 7 THE PROJECT SHALL NOT BE EXEMPT FROM ANY CONTRACTING, BIDDING OR OTHER RESTRICTIONS CURRENTLY EXISTING IN STATUTE OR ANY RULE OR 8 9 REGULATION ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF STATE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING PERTAINING TO SUCH CONSTRUCTION; AND FOR 10 11 RELATED PURPOSES.
- 12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 13 **SECTION 1.** The following shall be codified as Section
- 14 37-125-9, Mississippi Code of 1972:
- 15 37-125-9. (1) Jackson State University shall construct a
- 16 six hundred (600) room student housing project for all eligible
- 17 students. Students may be housed in such housing project on a
- 18 first-come, first-served basis or by any other legal procedure
- 19 established by Jackson State University.
- 20 (2) This section shall not exempt such construction from any
- 21 contracting, bidding or other restrictions currently existing in
- 22 statute or any rule or regulation adopted by the Board of Trustees

- 23 of State Institutions of Higher Learning pertaining to such
- 24 construction.
- 25 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 26 and after July 1, 2023.
