- 10 school day including, but not limited to, academic teams,
- 11 athletics, art, band, choir, honor societies, music and theater.
- 12 (2) Teams and individuals from nonpublic schools as defined
- in Section 37-13-91(i) may participate in extracurricular
- 14 activities against teams and schools that receive state funding.
- 15 (3) Schools that receive state funding may participate in
- 16 extracurricular activities against schools that are not accredited
- 17 by the State Department of Education and against schools that do
- 18 not receive state funding.

- 20 and after July 1, 2023.
