- 5 **SECTION 1.** Any citizen of this State, who is:
- 6 (a) A named beneficiary of a life insurance policy
- 7 where the insured is a member or veteran of the United States
- 8 Armed Forces, including National Guard or Reserves; and
- 9 (b) Married, unmarried and eighteen (18) years old, or
- 10 legally emancipated, shall be entitled to the benefits provided in
- 11 the policy, and for so doing the minority of such person is hereby
- 12 removed to authorize the same. The removal of minority shall
- 13 extend to the right to file suit under the policy and receive any
- 14 settlements under the policy.
- 15 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 16 and after July 1, 2023.
