SENATE BILL NO. 2679

1 AN ACT TO CREATE THE NATIONAL STATUARY HALL SELECTION 2 COMMISSION TO STUDY AND MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE SELECTION OF 3 TWO NEW HISTORIC FIGURES TO REPRESENT MISSISSIPPI IN THE NATIONAL 4 STATUARY HALL COLLECTION AT THE UNITED STATES CAPITOL; TO PROVIDE 5 THAT THE RECOMMENDATIONS SHALL BE FIGURES WHO BRING HONOR TO ALL MISSISSIPPIANS AND REFLECT THE DEMOGRAPHICS OF THE STATE AS A 6 7 WHOLE; TO PRESCRIBE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE COMMISSION AND TO 8 PROVIDE FOR ITS ORGANIZATION AND MEETINGS; TO PROVIDE THAT THE 9 COMMISSION SHALL MAKE WRITTEN RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE GOVERNOR AND THE LEGISLATURE NOT LATER THAN NOVEMBER 30, 2023; AND FOR RELATED 10 11 PURPOSES.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

13 **SECTION 1.** The Legislature finds and declares that:

14 (a) In 1864, the United States Congress established the
15 National Statuary Hall Collection in the Old Hall of the House of
16 Representatives in the United States Capitol and authorized each
17 state to contribute to the hall collection two (2) statues that
18 represent important historic figures of each state;

(b) Mississippi currently has on display in the
National Statuary Hall Collection statues of Jefferson Davis and
James Zachariah George given by the State of Mississippi in 1931;

(c) In 2000, the United States Congress enacted
legislation authorizing states to request that the Joint Committee
on the Library of Congress approve the replacement of statues that
states had provided for display in the hall collection;
(d) The State of Mississippi has a rich heritage in
art, literature, music, and history; and

(e) In the spirit of unity and for the sake of
displaying to our nation historic figures who bring honor to all
Mississippians, taking into account the demographics of the state
as a whole, the Legislature seeks to reopen consideration of the
figures whose statutes are to represent the State of Mississippi
in the National Statuary Hall Collection.

34 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) The National Statuary Hall Selection 35 Commission is created. The commission shall consist of nine (9) 36 members, to be appointed as follows:

37 (a) Three (3) members appointed by the Lieutenant38 Governor;

39 (b) Three (3) members appointed by the Speaker of the40 House; and

41 (c) Three (3) members appointed by the Governor, to 42 include:

43 (i) A representative from the Mississippi Economic44 Council;

45 (ii) A representative from the Mississippi Arts46 Commission; and

All appointments to the commission shall be made not later 49 than July 15, 2023. The chair of the commission shall be chosen 50 51 by majority vote of the members of the commission. Upon the joint 52 call of the Lieutenant Governor and the Speaker, the commission 53 shall meet as soon as practicable after the appointments have been 54 made and shall organize for business. A majority vote of the 55 members of the commission shall be required for the adoption of 56 any reports and recommendations. The Mississippi Department of 57 Archives and History shall provide meeting space and clerical 58 support for the operation of the commission.

59 (2) The commission shall have the following functions and60 duties:

61 (a) To hold regular public meetings when and where it62 sees fit;

(b) To receive written public comments in a manner andunder the terms and conditions as it sees fit;

(c) To collect, examine and consider all information
that it determines may be helpful in making recommendations for
two (2) new historic figures to represent Mississippi in the
National Statuary Hall Collection;

(d) To make any inquiries and conduct any business that
may assist the commission in developing its recommendations,
including consultation with experts, representatives of

72 organizations and associations, and others with relevant knowledge 73 or expertise;

74 (e) To keep minutes of its meetings and make those75 minutes available to the public; and

(f) To make written recommendations for the selection of two (2) new historic figures for the National Statuary Hall Collection, who bring honor to all Mississippians and reflect the demographics of the state as a whole, which recommendations shall be presented to the Governor and the Legislature not later than November 30, 2023.

82 (3) Members of the commission shall receive no compensation 83 for their service on the commission, but may receive reimbursement 84 for mileage and actual expenses as provided in Section 25-3-41, to 85 the extent that funds are available for that purpose.

86 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 87 and after its passage.
