SENATE BILL NO. 2695

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 57-26-5, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 EXTEND THE DEADLINE FOR THE MISSISSIPPI DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY TO 3 ISSUE CERTIFICATES APPROVING PARTICIPANTS IN THE TOURISM PROJECT 4 INCENTIVE PROGRAM; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. Section 57-26-5, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows:

8 57-26-5. (1) The MDA shall develop, implement and 9 administer the incentive program authorized in Sections 57-26-1 10 through 57-26-5 and shall promulgate rules and regulations 11 necessary for the development, implementation and administration 12 of such program.

(2) A person, corporation or other entity desiring to 13 14 participate in the incentive program authorized in Sections 57-26-1 through 57-26-5 must submit an application and an 15 application fee in the amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) 16 17 to the MDA. Such application must contain (a) plans for the proposed tourism project; (b) a detailed description of the 18 proposed tourism project; (c) the method of financing the proposed 19 S. B. 20 tourism project and the terms of such financing; (d) an 21 independent study that identifies the number of out-of-state 22 visitors anticipated to visit the project and the ratio of 23 out-of-state visitors to in-state visitors; and (e) any other 24 information required by the MDA. The Executive Director of the 25 MDA shall review the application and determine if it qualifies as a tourism project under this section and under the rules and 26 27 regulations promulgated pursuant to this section. If the 28 executive director determines the proposed tourism project 29 qualifies as a tourism project under this section and under the 30 rules and regulations promulgated pursuant to this section, he shall issue a certificate to the person, corporation or other 31 32 entity designating such person, corporation or other entity as an approved participant and authorizing the approved participant to 33 34 participate in the incentive program provided for in Sections 35 57-26-1 through 57-26-5. No certificate designating an entity as 36 an approved participant and authorizing the approved participant to participate in the incentive program shall be issued from and 37 38 after July 1, 2014, for tourism projects that are cultural retail 39 attractions, or from and after July 1, * * * 2027, for other 40 tourism projects. For tourism projects that are cultural retail attractions, no such issued certificate shall be altered or 41 extended after the date last approved as of July 1, 2020. 42

43 (3) The MDA shall cause a cost-benefit analysis of the
44 tourism project to be performed by a state institution of higher
