1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE CHANCERY COURT IN WHICH A DIVORCE 2 OR CHILD CUSTODY DECREE IS ENTERED MAY RETAIN CONTINUING EXCLUSIVE 3 JURISDICTION OVER ANY SUBSEQUENT MATTER ARISING FROM THE ENTERED 4 DECREE; TO PROVIDE THAT VENUE SHALL BE PROPER IN THE COUNTY AT THE 5 ORIGINAL FILING OR IN THE COUNTY WHERE ONE OF THE PARTIES RESIDES 6 FOR ANY SUBSEQUENT MATTER ARISING FROM THE ENTERED DECREE WHERE 7 ONE OF THE PARTIES TO THE ORIGINAL DECREE NO LONGER RESIDES IN THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE ORIGINAL DECREE WAS ENTERED; AND FOR RELATED 8 9 PURPOSES.

- 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 11 **SECTION 1.** The chancery court in which a divorce or child
- 12 custody decree is entered may retain continuing exclusive
- 13 jurisdiction over any subsequent matter arising from the entered
- 14 decree. If one (1) of the parties to the original decree no
- 15 longer resides in the county in which the decree was entered,
- 16 venue in chancery court for any subsequent matter arising from the
- 17 entered decree shall be proper in the county of the original
- 18 filing or in the county where one (1) of the parties resides.
- 19 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 20 and after July 1, 2023.
