SENATE BILL NO. 2830  
(As Passed the Senate)

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 67-3-46, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO  
2 REVISE THE LIST OF ENTITIES THAT MAY NOT HAVE INTEREST IN THE  
3 LICENSE, BUSINESS, ASSETS OR CORPORATE STOCK OF A WHOLESALER OR  
4 DISTRIBUTOR; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 **SECTION 1.** Section 67-3-46, Mississippi Code of 1972, is  
7 amended as follows:

8 67-3-46. (1) The provisions of subsection (2) of this  
9 section apply to the following entities:

10 (a) Any person engaged in the business of brewing or  
11 manufacturing beer or in the business of manufacturing or  
12 producing light wines or light spirit products;

13 (b) An officer, director, agent or employee of an  
14 entity described in paragraph (a) of this subsection;

15 (c) An affiliate of an entity described in paragraph  
16 (a) of this subsection, regardless of whether the affiliation is  
17 corporate or by management, direction or control \* \* \*;

18 (d) An entity that is the manufacturer of a product or  
19 substance that is infused into or becomes part of any beer, light



20 wine or light spirit products regardless or not if they  
21 manufacture the final product. This shall apply to all related  
22 companies, wholly-owned subsidiaries, joint ventures or any  
23 similar type of arrangement.

24 (2) No entity named in subsection (1) of this section may  
25 have any interest in the license, business, assets or corporate  
26 stock of a wholesaler or distributor to whom this chapter applies,  
27 except a security interest granted to the entity of the type  
28 provided for the Uniform Commercial Code in products sold to a  
29 wholesaler or distributor until the full purchase price has been  
30 paid therefor.

31 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
32 and after July 1, 2023, and shall stand repealed on June 30, 2023.
