(1) For the purposes of this section, the 11 following words and phrases shall have the meanings ascribed in 12 this section unless the context clearly indicates otherwise: 13 (a) "sUAS" means a small unmanned aircraft system, also 14 called a drone, including the unmanned aircraft itself and any additional support equipment, control stations, data links, 15 16 telemetry, communications and navigation equipment or any other equipment necessary to operate the unmanned aircraft. 17
