## SENATE BILL NO. 2853

AN ACT TO REQUIRE STATE PURCHASED SMALL UNMANNED AIRCRAFT
SYSTEMS OR DRONES TO BE MANUFACTURED IN THE UNITED STATES OF
AMERICA AND POSSESS COLLISION AVOIDANCE SYSTEMS; TO GRANT A 10%
BID PREFERENCE IN PUBLIC PROCUREMENT FOR SMALL UNMANNED AIRCRAFT
SYSTEMS AND RELATED SERVICES TO MISSISSIPPI MANUFACTURERS AND
SERVICING COMPANIES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 **SECTION 1.** (1) For the purposes of this section, the
- 9 following words and phrases shall have the meanings ascribed in
- 10 this section unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 11 (a) "sUAS" means a small unmanned aircraft system, also
- 12 called a drone, including the unmanned aircraft itself and any
- 13 additional support equipment, control stations, data links,
- 14 telemetry, communications and navigation equipment or any other
- 15 equipment necessary to operate the unmanned aircraft.
- 16 (b) "Domestic manufacturer" means a manufacturing
- 17 company incorporated and headquartered in the United States of
- 18 America which manufactures drones at a facility in the United
- 19 States of America.

- 20 (c) "Domestic sUAS company" means a company which
- 21 provides maintenance, repair, and other technical services for
- 22 small unmanned aircraft systems, including drones, which is
- 23 incorporated, headquartered and primarily provides such services
- 24 in the United States of America.
- 25 (d) "Collision avoidance system" means a system of
- 26 hardware or software designed to mitigate collision risk for
- 27 drones.
- 28 (2) Beginning July 1, 2023, all small unmanned aircraft
- 29 systems and drones purchased by the State of Mississippi or any
- 30 agency or political subdivision thereof shall be purchased
- 31 exclusively from a domestic manufacturer and shall possess
- 32 collision avoidance systems. All maintenance, repair and other
- 33 technical services on drones owned by the State of Mississippi or
- 34 any agency or political subdivision thereof shall be performed by
- 35 a domestic sUAS company. All infrastructure inspection services
- 36 requiring the use of sUAS and contracted for on behalf of the
- 37 State shall shall be performed using domestically manufactured
- 38 sUAS.
- 39 (3) In public procurement under Title 31, Chapter 7,
- 40 domestic manufacturers operating within the State of Mississippi
- 41 shall be granted a ten percent (10%) bid preference over
- 42 non-Mississippi manufacturers and domestic sUAS companies shall be
- 43 granted a ten percent (10%) bid preference over non-Mississippi
- 44 manufacturers.

- Section 1 of this act shall be codified in Title 45 SECTION 2.
- 31, Chapter 7, Mississippi Code of 1972. 46
- SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 47
- and after July 1, 2023. 48
